- a. Sandor continues looking at teams' placements
  - i. how teams are doing in current divisions
  - ii. how far teams have to travel for games, are there divisions where we could decrease travel time?
- b. Weather has been a huge factor this season – limiting practices and games
- c. Coaches' Youth Summer Camp flyer is available and will be distributed soon
  - i. Camp will donate \$5/kid back to the club

**Academy Update:**

1. Still looking to try and find make up dates for some of the cancelations
2. June 6 is last Saturday for academy
3. Had 3<sup>rd</sup> session this weekend even though fields were muddy
4. Developing a curriculum for when kids “graduate” from academy to travel

**President:** (Gabriel Younker – not present)

**Vice President 1:** (Mike Folino)

1. Will help facilitate board call to discuss next season’s registration rates

**Vice President 2:** (Jenn Morabito)

**Fields/Parks:**

1. Richfield Woods – right now mud appeared to be mostly on top and ground underneath was pretty solid
2. Bath Park remained closed longer than expected due to logs being left after tree removal – trustees wanted to have them removed before opening the park to the public
3. Bath fields won’t be available in the fall, but thoughts for when they are open again
  - a. Lower field drainage is bad – especially where drainage ditch was dug in the middle of the field
    - i. Consider lining the upper field for both 11v11 and 9v9 – especially if more 11v11 games are being played on the turf
4. High School turf is reserved on Sundays through the end of the season – will try to continue in the fall if possible
5. Fields for the Fall – Jenn will reach out to Whitney re: Elms Fields
  - a. Elms is donation based – do not have an exact amount
6. Dream/Goal - we could eventually help fund a new/additional turf field for Revere

**Secretary:** (Sarah Fearn)

**Registration:**

1. Discussed registration for next year and how much we should be charging – consideration of how much we want to carry over each year for equipment replacement, capital investments, investments in coaching, and how to assist families who don't feel they can afford increased rates
  - a. Mike will schedule a call this week for board to discuss further and set registration costs, once all information is compiled
    - i. Sandor gathered and shared information with the board on costs for other local youth soccer programs to compare.
    - ii. Several members offered comparisons on what other Revere youth sports cost and what other community soccer programs cost
      1. Sarah will compile for review before the board meets
    - iii. Sarah and Megan reviewed last fall's tournament costs to determine how much it costs per player to register the whole club
      1. Tournament registration and estimated coaching costs was \$12,133
  - b. Discussed the need to update advertising
    - i. Need to articulate to people what they can expect from registration: how many hours of training, number of games, qualifications of coaches
    - ii. Need to highlight the advances we've made over last few seasons – coaches upgraded certifications, additional footskills sessions, increased coaching at academy to include Akron U players
  - c. Need to make sure Uniform Ordering instructions are included on advertising and registration confirmation

**Committee Reports:**

**1. Uniforms/Medals**

- a. Additional medals were ordered for academy to match the ones we had left over from fall – will cost \$347.50 for enough for all academy members
  - i. Invoice was approved by the board before the order was placed
- b. Mike Jansen will work with NC Soccer to get new uniforms on website this week – so it can be available when registration opens
  - i. Uniforms must be ordered by June – exact date being finalized to guarantee arrival for fall season
  - ii. Travel Uniform – full kit costs \$184 – includes, 2 jerseys, 2 shorts, 2 socks and a bag
  - iii. Academy Uniforms – full kit costs \$50
    1. Academy will wear all 1 color – teams will be split with pinneys
  - iv. Site will have a drop-down menu where parents will select players' grade and site will take you to the required kit
    1. Each grade will have unique numbers assigned to each player registered
      - a. Players can not choose their numbers



- ii. Proposal and flyers were shared – everyone in attendance thought it was a good idea
- iii. Niki Marich will be reaching out to parent managers to arrange times to share materials she has for the teams.
