



GPPLL Select Teams

What is a select team?

- A select team is a team that participates in post-season tournament play outside of the Little League International tournaments.

Why participate on a select team?

- Baseball is fun! We know that there are a limited number of players on the tournament team rosters, and select teams allow more GPPLL players to have additional practice and competitive baseball experiences after the regular season ends.

Who can play on a select team?

- Select teams are teams made up of GPPLL players of the same age group who are not participating on a tournament team. Depending on interest, age groups may be combined into one team (e.g., 11 and 12 year-olds).

When does this take place?

- Select teams will be put together once the tournament team selections are announced, in early June. The dates of the select team tournaments will be determined by the managers.
