



Tournament Team Managers

Who can be a tournament team manager?

- Any coach or manager from the current season is eligible.

How are tournament team managers selected?

- All candidates who have expressed interest are interviewed by the GPPLL president and/or vice-president. They make a recommendation to the GPPLL Board, who approve the manager selection.

When are managers selected?

- In early May, the GPPLL Board asks all managers and coaches if they are interested in managing a tournament team. The interview process usually takes about a week, and managers are selected with 10-14 days before team selection.

How are coaches selected?

- Managers are permitted to have two coaches on the roster. Coach selection is discussed with the manager candidates during the interview process, and the managers select their coaches after the managers are approved. Once the manager selects their coaches, those coaches are then subject to approval by the Board.

Is there a role to get involved without being an official manager or coach?

- Absolutely. Teams always need help with practices, especially when a manager or coach has a conflict.
