BOARD MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

All GFYBSO Board Members must read, sign, and date this Code of Conduct.

As a volunteer Board Member of the Glens Falls Youth Baseball and Softball Board of Directors, you have an important role in the delivery of a successful Baseball and Softball program to our community. The Executive Board of Directors would like to thank you for your dedication and for volunteering your time to make GFYBSO a better organization.

We hope that your reason(s) for joining the GFYBSO Board include making decisions that are for the benefit of the league as a whole. Therefore, we ask that you agree to the following:

1. I will enforce the rules and by-laws of the Glens Falls Youth Baseball and Softball Organization.
2. I will put the safety of our players, spectators, coaches, and umpires first. I will not participate in any verbal or physical altercation other than to diffuse a situation.
3. If I am also a coach, I will not attempt to use my Board Member position to improperly influence the drafting process, to improperly influence the All-Star selection process, or otherwise use my position to gain an unfair advantage for my child or for my team.
4. I will not speak negatively about Board members, Coaches, Parents, Players, Fans or Umpires in any setting other than official GFYBSO board meetings, or GFYBSO executive sessions. And even in such cases, I will conduct myself in a professional manner.
5. It is understood that differences of opinions will always exist. When they occur, I will handle and resolve the differences in a professional manner that would be expected of an adult.
6. As a member of this Board, I understand that I am open to criticism from the public and I will handle in the appropriate and a professional manner that would be expected from an adult.

7. It is understood that all volunteers Board Members have responsibilities outside of the GFYBSO. However, we must require a minimum commitment level from each Board Member. All Board members must complete the following minimum requirements or be subject to removal from the GFYBSO Board of Directors by a majority vote:

- Complete at least two (2) Director on Duty (DOD) shifts during the 7- week regular season (unless the GFYBSO Board of Directors exempts you from this requirement by a majority vote). You cannot complete these DOD shifts while coaching a game.
- Attending at least 25% of the Board meetings each year (unless the GFYBSO Board of Directors exempts you from this requirement by a majority vote).

I have read and understand the above Glens Falls Youth Baseball and Softball Organization Member Code of Conduct and agree to perform my Board of Director duties per this Code of Conduct. Intentional disregard for these responsibilities will subject me to further action, including possible removal from the GFYBSO Board of Directors.
