ELIGIBILITY

Greater Oneida Little League is open to children residing within the boundaries of the Oneida City School District and the Stockbridge Valley Central School District who meet the following age criteria:

Boys who will be between the ages 6-16* on August 31, 2022

*Senior League has been established for players between ages of 13-16

Girls who will be between the ages 6-12 on December 31, 2021
