

TREAT TICKET & PICTURE MONEY

Dear Families:

Following games upon clean up of dugout and stands each player will receive a treat ticket that is worth \$.50 in the concession stand. Because our team will be playing 12 games, the total charge for the treat tickets is \$6.00. Please turn in your child's treat ticket money to me by Monday, April 15th, 2019 as well as receipt of information signature form which is required for child to play.

In addition, the photographer has provided each player with an envelope for your T-ball/Baseball/Softball pictures. This envelope is to be completed and returned directly to the photographer's assistant on Picture Day, which is **SATURDAY May 4th, 2019**. Please remember, there will be <u>no</u> late pictures. We employ several photographers for this day, and run within five (5) minutes of the time our team is scheduled. If you are late, chances are you will miss pictures. Enclosed is a picture flyer with our time. PLEASE BE ON TIME! NO FOOD/DRINKS PLEASE.

If you decide not to purchase individual pictures, please see that your child is present for the team picture. Homewood Baseball presents all team sponsors with plagues and pictures of the team they sponsor.

Players will not receive treat tickets from their manager/team parent until the cleanup responsibilities are fulfilled after each game.

Please make sure your child has their name and telephone number on their hat and glove.

Playoff games (does not apply to T-Ball or Rookie "B" leagues) will follow the regularly scheduled season. Everyone has Stand duty at playoff time, unless your team agrees to hire a worker for each playoff game. Every player's family must agree to pay for the hired worker.
