### Recent Expenses:

If all outstanding checks were issued, it would take us down to a balance of \$14,094

Outstanding payments: Rick Hare \$2,314, Aiken trash, turn 4 toilets & \$500 for golf cart

### Recurring Expenses: (no updates)

- Field lawncare/dragging: \$1,000/month = planning on using volunteers in 2026
- Toilets: \$250/month; Electric: ~\$75-\$100/month (~\$40 winter)
- Insurance: \$25 per girl/year (\$925 paid for fall)
- Garbage: \$230 per 3 months (weekly pickup – explore bi-weekly or sponsorship)

### Fundraising:

  - We're excited to announce that RGAA will be receiving a \$5,000 anonymous donation this week, and another \$5,000 donation in the next 3-6 months! 😊
- **Completed:**
  - Ellwood Light Up Night fundraiser: \$457 raised = Thank you Ashely, Sydney, & Dawn! (And Maureen for the equipment)
- **Upcoming:**
  - New Ideas:
  - Have more options at opening day – vendors & food trucks. (Electricity not available for vendors)
    - Have snack shack open, but only non-perishables
  - If the vendor is not willing to give a % of sales, we will ask for a service fee per vendor
  - Parking = Max 5 trucks – need to think of weather – may be wet and cold
- **Future Ideas:**
  - Pool night fundraiser - February

- Golf outing –
  - Strawberry Ridge, Blackhawk, Delmar
  - Possibly work with Zelig BBQ company
  - Beaver Valley Country Club – public now – in Patterson – also a possibility

  - Possibly consider doing it on a Friday

## **Team Updates**

## **Facilities & Equipment**

- Tractor #1: Oil leak repaired; new switch and belt; should be good to go now
- Tractor #2: Possible PTO/clutch issue (~\$400 repair estimate)
- Quad: Non-operational; consider scrap
- Golf cart acquired for \$500 – Thanks Chris for finding this opportunity for us!
  - When dragging, it is important to drag from outside to inside. Vendors who have provided field quotes noted that we were doing the opposite.

## **2026 Season Timeline**

- Parade: April 18 – road shuts down at 10. Girls to arrive by 9:30
- Regular season: April 20 – June 3
- Playoffs: Week of June 4
- Championship: June 15

- Our goal is to have registration open in January 2026 (complete)
