

# Buying a Bat

## Age

Using your age as a guide, use the chart below to determine the bat length that fits your body.

Determine Your Bat Length by Age	
Age	Bat length
5-7 years old	24"-26"
8-9 years old	26"-28"
10 years old	28"-29"
11-12 years old	30"-31"
13-14 years old	31"-32"
15-16 years old	32"-33"
17+ years old	34"

## Height and weight

- Height and weight are usually better ways to determine what bat length may work best for you
- Once again, use the height and weight chart to give you a general idea of the length of bat that fits your body

Age	Infield	Outfield
Under 8	9"-11"	10.5"-11.5"
9 to 13	10"-11"	11"-11.5"
High school or Adult	11.5"-12.5"	12.5"-13"

## Slowpitch Glove Sizing Chart by Position

Size	Position
12"-13"	Infield
12.5"-14"	Outfield
