POOL PLAY TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES: Ties within each pool between two teams will be broken by head-to-head record, with the winner receiving the higher seeding. If three or more teams tie, the fewest runs allowed based on a 6 inning game will be the next tie breaker. This tie breaking system is the official "Round Robin" system approved by Little League Headquarters and the Eastern Regional Little League Office for pool play.
