Based on Governor Evers' recent statewide mandate closing K-12 schools indefinitely, and because the health and safety of our players, coaches and families is our principal concern, we have made the decision to cancel all KMSL activities (Practices & Games) until at least April 6. We will be continually evaluating this evolving situation to determine appropriate next steps.

We are sympathetic to the inconvenience this may cause our families. Please know that we did not come to this decision lightly. After consulting various public and private health partners, in addition to state and national youth sports and community associations, we believe temporarily suspending all activities is the safest and smartest choice for everyone involved.
