

In-House Divisional All-Star Game Selection Process

In an effort to standardize the process of selecting players to participate in the All-Star game, to be played at the conclusion of the season by teams in the Minors division, SYCLL has adopted the following process:

- ◆ A league representative will distribute voting ballots to each team. Players will select three players they feel would best represent their team as an all-star, based on baseball skill, knowledge, and/or spirit. Players may not select themselves to participate.
- ◆ Ballots will be collected from each team by a league representative.
- ◆ Votes will be tallied, and parents/guardians of the selected players will be notified by their division's player agent to confirm availability for the all-star game on the chosen date.
- ◆ In the event of a player being unable to play in the all-star game, the player with the next highest vote count will be notified.
- ◆ When all available spots are confirmed, the league will announce the players selected to participate in the all-star games.
