VOLUNTEER HANDBOOK/ORIENTATION PACKET

All Boys & Girls Club Volunteers who have direct, repetitive interactions with youth must complete a documented orientation/on-boarding process. All volunteers participating will be tracked by Boys & Girls Club Staff.

All Boys & Girls Club volunteers must be screened and pass a BGCA approved background check and reference check prior to volunteering.

The Boys & Girls Club of the Berkshires shall secure a criminal background check on all staff (including minors), board members, and any individual serving on a board serving committee. All volunteers who have direct, repetitive interaction with youth must have a background check. All background checks shall be secured prior to employment, volunteer engagement or other affiliations and at least once every 12 months thereafter.

The Boys & Girls Club of the Berkshires shall conduct reference checks on any candidate for employment or volunteer with direct, repetitive interaction with youth. Boys & Girls Club of the Berkshires must inquire with any potential candidate for employment or volunteer as to previous Boys & Girls Club experience.

All employees and volunteers must read and review the Boys & Girls Club of the Berkshires Child & Club Safety Handbook.

All employees and volunteers with repetitive interaction with youth must complete Mandatory Training through Spillett Leadership University prior to employment and or volunteer participation.
