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#### 5) Reports of Committees

#### a) Fundraising:

- Golf outing August 17<sup>th</sup> Starting at 1pm. Need to start looking for prizes and sponsors. Will do 50/50 Raffle. Will ask bartenders to monitor consumption of alcohol. Course charging \$35 per golfer. We charge \$65 per golfer. Shooting for 108 golfers. Plan to use the UTV for beer cart. Needs washed and trailered to the outing.

#### a) Volleyball:
