From the PSC By-Laws Article VII.B.4.c VACANCIES IN OFFICE paragraph v.: "In the event any officer is excused for a meeting, said Officer may delegate a temporary replacement or may have any other member of the Board of Directors give their respective report and/or perform the duties of said Office. Said BOD member may delegate voting privileges and responsibilities at BOD and GM Meetings. No BOD member may control more than one quarter (1/4) of the total of eligible voting privileges of the BOD, including his/her own voting privilege. In the event that 1/4 of all the votes is not a whole number, it shall be rounded DOWN to the nearest whole number, to determine the maximum number of votes a BOD member may control at any meeting they would otherwise be eligible to have voting privileges."

(Please note at BOD meetings, only voting board of directors are allowed to vote, though membership may partake in discussion prior to voting on a motion. A motion must be put forth by a Voting Board Member, and 2nd by a voting Board Member in order for a vote to take place. The President only casts tie-breaking votes. See above for listing of voting Board Members. All Board Meetings are open to the Membership.)

III. Unfinished Business from Last Meeting:

1. **Town Rec Soccer Games:** My name is Matthew Ware with the Highland Park Recreation Department, and I was reaching out to start communications with your programs, to play games together in the Fall (September - November). We have 2 age ranges that are Recreation skill level (2nd and 3rd grade) 4 teams and (4th and 5th grade) 2 teams. We would like to know if you would be interested in a few games for the upcoming fall season, we are unable to play on Fridays and Saturday.
 - a. **September:** They are going to try to get it going. Tad was in touch with Anne Marie.
 - b. **October:** Tabled – Tad reached out to make arrangements. The plan is to pilot games with 6-8th grade age groups
 - c. **November:** Tabled
 - d. **January:** Tabled
 - e. **February: Tad will reach out to Highland Park to invite them to the 7v7 Festival scheduled for 5/16**

2. **CPR Training:** Every two years. Mike to schedule next CPR training date
 - a. **August:** Reached out to 2 companies. SDR Training \$75/hour for 2/1/2 hour CPR and First Aid Class. Waiting on JAG, will follow up. Dan reached out to Trey at Red Bulls. Want to schedule this for October sometime.
 - b. **September:** \$30 class is not with NJ Youth soccer anymore. Iliia suggested to see if the YMCA offers a class for this.
 - c. **October:** No response from YMCA. Dennis motioned for CPR class set for winter session, Jeff Sundelof 2nd, Votes: 16 YES. Passed. Class to be scheduled with date TBD in mid-Jan/mid-Feb @ 7pm
 - d. **November:** February 3rd – all coaches need to be trained.
 - e. **January:** 18 coaches registered. 2 open spots remaining, 20 max allowed. Yasmeen to register. Zarah maintaining log
 - f. **February: Second session scheduled for 3/16, 5-9pm at the YMCA. Certificates from previous session will be published next week**

3. **Porta John Fence** – quote to replace, but Tierney said he would replace it.
 - a. **June:** No updates as of yet.
 - b. **July:** Tabled. No word from Dennis or Tierney
 - c. **August:** Townships has removed damaged porta john and the fence. Not sure if they will replace the fence. Dennis will follow up with Tierney to see if they will replace. Mike looked into pricing for different materials. \$1400 for pvc.
 - d. **September:** Tabled
 - e. **October:** Tabled. No update. Dennis to follow up
 - f. **November:** Tabled
 - g. **January:** Tabled
 - h. **February: Tabled**

4. **PSC Board Volunteer Reminder – SafeSport Certification:** Email from Ilia went out about volunteer requirements for the Board. This needs to be done by the end of September.
 - a. **September:** Tabled – SafeSport needs to be done by October Meeting.
 - b. **October:** TABLED – still incomplete. Board members must re-certify
 - c. **November:** January 2026 – needs to be done.
 - d. **January:** Tabled – board members still need to complete
 - e. **February: Tabled – everyone to complete by March**

5. **PSC Fall Classic Beverage Containers/Barrels Need to be Moved to Conackamack shed.** Jim noted that containers without lids can be discarded.
 - a. **January:** Tabled. Too much snow
 - b. **February: Tabled. Too much snow**

6. **Plan to exit the SCORE contract early - Part 1 of SCORE Contract Exit Plan - Review Chuck’s proposal to exit the contract**

Email from Chuck:

I would like to propose the following with regards to our SCORE contract and the issues we, as a club, have faced. If you (and Jeff Salles) agree, then can you bring this up at tonight's meeting.

We should take steps to end our agreement with SCORE effective **December 1, 2025**, by requesting formal release from the contract.

Action: Ask Rey and Daniel to draft a letter to SCORE outlining our position and requesting release. The letter should:

- List the issues we have encountered, including:
 - Delayed delivery of recreation uniforms
 - Perceived security breach resulting in hacked credit cards of our parents and board members
 - Very delayed delivery of travel uniforms
 - Lack of any statement or acknowledgment from SCORE Corporate regarding the August issues
 - Delayed delivery of other items (e.g., soccer balls)
 - Loss of trust in SCORE’s ability to deliver reliably in the future
- Acknowledge that we appreciate the **300 green placeholder jerseys** they provided at no cost. While they arrived late on the first day of our tournament, they did help partially. However, this also created a significant amount of unplanned work for our volunteers in distribution.
- Point out that our club **did not request any SCORE polos for coaches or board members** (~36 shirts) that were included in the original contract and were to be provided at no cost.
- Indicate that we are willing to **purchase any remaining custom travel jersey kits** that SCORE has in stock under the existing agreement. This will allow us to support any new players who join existing teams in the spring. (New spring teams can be outfitted in the existing green placeholder jerseys.)

- a. **October:** Jim motioned to approve Chuck’s proposal to Prematurely end the SCORE Contract. Dennis seconded the Motion. Votes: 16 YES. Passed. Mike and Chuck will work with counsel to put this in motion. Tabled.
- b. **November:** Uniforms are finally coming in.
- c. **January:** Conversation with SCORE sales rep on Monday 1/19 – rep acknowledged SCORE fell victim to cybercrime. Throughout Dec-Jan, there were multiple discussions about travel uniform

quandary. It was decided that we will remain with SCORE through the Spring 2026 season because of the 9 month lead time required if we switched to Go Soccer.

- d. **February: The quote for GoSoccer uniform kits went up to \$145, no shipping. Lead order time would be six weeks. Mike recommended staying with Score until the contract ends. Chuck suggested PSC should pursue delivery of Coaches' shirts per the contract, and a follow up review of the contact about a year before expiry. Motioned by Zarah O., Second by Jim O., Vote: 15 Yes, 0 No, 0 Abstain. Approved. Closed.**

7. Part 2 of SCORE Contract Exit Plan- Short-Term Recreation Plan

Once released, we can immediately move forward in selecting a new vendor for our **Spring Recreation Program uniforms**. There are multiple viable options available.

- a. **October:** We will wait for Chuck to provide more information regarding viable options
- b. **November:** Want to change for Rec but not travel. Will change them in 2 years. Switch Ilia and Chuck out uniforms and us Go Soccer for the spring. We are currently paying \$28 per kit now. Mike to take over. Discuss more in January. Will talk to go soccer about socks and shorts.
- c. **January:** See Mike's Update in Appendix I. Tabled until sample uniform is received
- d. **February: See 6 above. Approved and Closed.**

8. Part 3 of SCORE Contract Exit Plan - Long-Term Travel Plan: NEW UNIFORM VENDOR

We should make a board-level decision regarding the future of our **custom travel kit design:**

- Either retain our custom design and partner with a different vendor that offers sublimation, or
- Retire the custom design in **June 2026** and transition back to a traditional jersey kit.

This should be a board decision either way.

- a. **October:** Tabled. How will this be perceived by parents?
- b. **November:** Tabled – June 2027 (change over)
- c. **January:** Tabled
- d. **February: See 6 above. Approved and Closed.**

9. Wristbands for rec program need to be ordered. Mike will handle the order

- a. **February: Will have to determine how many are needed and pad the order with extras. Tad and Mike to check inventory. Chuck to send Mike the contact.**

10. Meagan Martineau will be added to the next PSC Newsletter as the winner of the State Soccer Shoot. She will be attending the Mid-Atlantic Soccer Shoot in March

- a. **February: Tabled. The Mid-Atlantic Soccer Shoot will be held on 3/9/2026 in York, PA**

11. Mike is asking for a volunteer to research sponsorship solicitations for PSC website

- a. **February: No volunteers. Will be handled on a case by case basis. Closed.**

12. There are existing delinquent credit cards- only a handful, not too much

- a. **February: Not a handful - \$6,353.10 owed to PSC – all travel**

13. Picture Day has been scheduled for 4/25/2026. Mike will specify a 9 am – 1pm time frame. This is also the 1st day for Little Kickers and Futures. Might be a problem for uniforms for Little Kickers and TopSoccer due to season start of 4/25

- a. **February: Mike will change the date**

14. **Referee class – must discuss location considerations**
 - a. **February: No response from Steve. Closed**

15. **YMCA held an Introduction to Soccer session – 1 free class to introduce kids to soccer. Will be a 4 week session. 5-6 kids signed up. 1st Class to begin 1/23/2026**
 - a. **February: First session successful; Only 2 kids showed up for second session. Tabled.**

16. **Playmetrics has acquired SportsConnect platform and will discontinue PSC’s registration platform:** Chuck advised we should wait for NJYS’ decision. Per Jim, we have time until the fall of 2027 to further research a replacement platform. No other free platforms exist. Yasmeen expressed concern about registration history. Zarah has already downloaded all registration information. We will ensure that all registration data is downloaded before transition to new platform occurs.
 - a. **February: No updates yet. Preference is to continue to wait for NJYS decision. Mike will make inquiry during conference. Tabled.**

17. **Red Bulls Annual Conference on 3/1/2026: Interested attendees must register**
 - a. **February: The Myers, Mike, Tad, Jeff Salles, Yasmeen and Keith will attend to represent PSC**

18. **Jersey Knights membership is flagging and officials are seeking to partner their travel program with our rec program? Chuck invited them to join PSC**
 - a. **February: No response. Closed**

19. **Alex Abreu attended the meeting to promote a PHS to PSC girls’ soccer connection.** He is pursuing a more positive girls’ involvement in PSC and will promote and require representation in PSC events. His vision aligns with Chuck’s vision, where the high school integration with PSC should be a part of the PSC Five Year Plan to maintain consistent community-building touch points to bridge PHS soccer with PSC. Alex proposes to commit two players per week to volunteer with PSC and keep the girls engaged with the soccer program. Dan will structure it and Alex will email potential game plan/ideas. Dan suggested that Alex and PHS host an introductory clinic in August for PSC girls entering HS.

February: Mike shared the info with the girls’ coaches and 5-7 girls were interested in getting involved. Alex would encourage the girls to join soccer practices. Chuck and Ilia mentioned NJYS certification requirements (3 online courses). Chuck will email requirements. PSC will cover cost. Alex also suggested a Bring a Friend day/weekend, similar to an event that COPA hosted. Members agreed it was a good idea. Table discussion until October. Mike to add a calendar hold.

20. **Registration for Spring 2026 rec soccer starts Friday, 1/23/2026**
 - a. **February: 262 rec players so far = 65% of goal, ~100 more to go. Jim requested info to update website. Late Registration Fee will be in effect starting 3/6. Hard close on 3/13. Tabled**

21. **Girls Festival of Soccer – Date MUST be determined by the February meeting**
 - a. **February: Set to 5/8, with rain date on 5/9. Mike to coordinate with DJ. Ilia to produce flyer – will be 2-sided with tryouts on one side and Girls Festival of Soccer on the other**

22. Findley Petiote, coach of U9 Liverpool also attended the board meeting to request whether coaches can have more input in tryout evaluations.
 - a. February: Coaches will be able to provide feedback for tryout evaluations. Tabled

IV. New Business:

1. Yasmeen brought up a request for a PSC donation for a cerebral palsy fundraiser to purchase a carrier for Arjun Patel, brother of soccer player with Juventus. Jeff Sundelof motioned to donate \$100, Seconded by Jim O. Vote: 15 Yes, 0 Not, 0 Abstain. Passed. Approved. Closed.
2. Red Bulls Summer Select – they are asking to host one event in Piscataway. PSC unsure of field availability. Chuck will follow up.
3. Parent Meeting for Travel & Rec parents scheduled on 3/18 via Zoom
4. Piscataway Board of Ed budget shortfall of ~\$4.4million, primarily due to soaring health insurance premiums. Potential implications include staff reductions, increase in bussing costs, potential increase in rental fees – unsure of what that means, but concerned about potential trickledown effect for PSC – gym space usage is currently free.
5. Team First-Aid kits – we need to know who needs kits
6. Chuck reminded the board that we need to think about developing a Five Year Plan - Where do we see the club? Must have a discussion along with a deeper dive to review the budget

2. Tournament Director – Mike Majorczak: *Reached out to Sport Line to get a quote. \$3,145 to build 17 fields and up to \$1,000 credit to demo machines during tournament. Mike to counter with free build, free spot at the tournament, and free advertising. PSC covers paint costs*
3. Executive Vice President – Tom Roberts: *Absent*
4. Director of Coaching – Chuck Myers: *See Appendix II for BOD Monthly Dashboard. Hardship cost now up to 5.08% /\$12,836. Continue monitoring-situation will be reviewed on a case by case basis.*

8. Webmaster – Jim Opitz: *Dicks Sporting Goods coupon has been posted on the website- coupon will be effective between 3/13 – 3/16. Jim bows down to Chuck, Ilia and Mike*
9. Travel Soccer - Jeff Sundelof, Chuck Myers, Jeffery Salles, Dennis Espinosa & Luis Raymondi: *Jeff Salles – No issues so far. Asked where practices will be held. Mike advised wait until grounds are more firm. Jeff Sundelof advised grabbing some bow nets from shed in the meantime if conditions are favorable. Need to figure out official practice location for coach led practices. Jeff Sundelof will review practice schedule with Jeff Salles, Lou and Dennis. Top of mind for Travel: Age group adjustment mandated US Youth Soccer. Thinking about adjusting age group by school grade. Must be handled diplomatically, thinking Oct 1st, similar to school schedule. Player pool for team selections will be sent out without team or coach. Selection will happen over 3 nights.*
10. Recreational VPs – Yasmeen Ash and Tad Powell: *Tad will order more balls for Little Kickers. 68 registered so far. Capacity of 80. Mike will handle uniform order. Will need help on opening day. Website request: Change all references to “coaches” in rec pages to note “volunteers” – Ilia noted that they would still need SafeSport certification and background check.*
11. Member at Large – Equipment Coordinator - Keith Koenig: *Waiting for count on First-Aid kit*
12. Public Information Officer – George Roussey: *Absent*

Uniform Report - MWM 1/22/26

Rec Uniform Update

1. I have been in discussions with Go Soccer, their proposed Kit is \$38/Kit, far more than the approximate \$24 kit we were paying with Score.
2. Yasmeen reviewed the samples provided by Go Soccer, and was not impressed, she would prefer to stay with Score for now.
3. Last week Chuck, Ilia, Tad and Mike met via Zoom: Since Go Soccer stated it was already too late to order uniforms for the Spring(9 month lead time required), **it was decided to stay with Score for the Spring Season.** Score has advised they have a large stock of uniforms we used last Fall that we can have for this Spring. **They advised a 3 week lead time.**
4. Mike stated he would use a 6 week lead time to provide some cushion. Based on that, uniforms need to be ordered by March 3rd to provide a 3 week cushion.
5. **Go Soccer stated there is a 9 month lead time on Rec Uniforms, he is willing to purchase the stock, but needs a guarantee from us we will go with a kit this Fall. No decision has been made for the Fall. A decision needs to be made this week if we are going to go with their kit for the Fall.**

Travel Uniform Update

I had a phone conversation with Anthony from Score. He advised they have admitted to a hacking and sent out letters to parents via US Snail Mail. He wasn't sure what was included in the letter or if they offered a free year of credit monitoring. Mike checked with the Travel Board Members and Lou confirmed they received a letter, Mike asked if he could scan and send a copy to him.

Anthony also advised the Upper Level Executives Sean and Justin that Mike and Chuck were speaking with were let go due to their poor performance with the hacking issue.

We are currently having parents of players added to existing teams and Spring Teams to order uniforms from Score until we make a final decision on Score. I do not want to make our parents buy new uniform kits this Summer, the current kit should stay with the club for 2-3 years.

Uniform Options for the Next 18 months

Over the month of December and January I have corresponded with many uniform vendors and have come up with the following options, all are based on matching or staying with our current Kit for the next 18 months.

1. Score - Stay with Score
 - a. \$100 per kit
 - b. 4-6 week, during peak season, otherwise 3 weeks.
 - c. Have they solved their ordering issues

- d. Anthony blamed the issues on the hack and integration with a new ordering system. He stated it has been resolved.
 - e. Recent orders have been received in approximately 3-4 weeks.
2. Go Soccer, they state they can match our kit.
 - a. \$105 per kit
 - b. 4-5 week lead time
 3. Challenger
 - a. \$120 per kit, they state they can match our kit.
 - b. 4-5 week lead time
 4. Squad Locker
 - a. \$135 per kit, they state they can match our kit.
 - b. 2-4 week lead time
 5. Podium
 - a. \$158 per kit, they state they can match our kit.
 - b. 4-5 week lead time
 6. Cisco, not consider due to only club orders, parents can not order direct, no online store.
 7. Capelli Sports, not considered due to 10 week lead time.
 8. Nike, not considered, does not due sublimation printing, would be like our Adidas uniforms in the past and the work with Soccer Post in NJ.

I request the Board to decide on how to proceed with Travel and Rec Uniforms this evening.
