## Directors November Reports

**Boys Basketball:** Practices started for ¾ and .5/6 teams. In houses practices begin 11/10. Registration Summary: 2025 – 61 participants, 2024 – 73 participants, 2023 – 61 participants, 2022 – 63 participants, 2021 – 60 participants, 2020 – COVID 20 participants, 2019 – 58 participants, 2018 – 50 participants, 2017 – 43 participants, 2016– 60 participants, 2015 (Mike's first year) 17 participants at 5/6, 16 at ¾ and in house? *Interested in doing a cash raffle again – voted and approved.*

**Field Hockey:** The season officially ended 10/19. Our 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders players participated in a full field scrimmage that ends every season with our league. This is designed to prepare girls whom are moving up to middle school. We played SPYA ending in 0-0 and Northwestern ending in a 3-1 win. **Football Cheerleading & Competition Cheerleading:** Football spirit stand did not do as well as we hoped it would. Roughly \$600 in cash and \$800 in cards. We paid \$800 for spirit wear from a t-shirt vendor from last year's comp, in hopes to make the money back. Basket raffle – proceeds benefit pediatric cancer?. Comp cheer practice on Wednesdays is about to be cut an hour for adult volleyball. We had our first cheer competition on Sunday – girls did well (difficult teams). 6U-10U – didn't place, 12U placed 3<sup>rd</sup>, 14U placed 3<sup>rd</sup>. Spirit award was brought home for the 1<sup>st</sup> session. We are paying more for tshirts (man we normally go through hasn't responded) Everyone is charging \$14-\$18 a tshirt. We just paid \$2,700 for Spirit Jam Volunteer Tshirts. Home Competition is this Saturday. Theme this year is Taylor Swift, in my cheer era. We will be hosting 9 different schools. Trying to figure out spacing due to very limited space the school is allowing us to have Extra custodians and extra security is needed – more \$\$
