C. Ad-Hoc Board Topics

1.Dome Update: The Lakeville dome will be ready in November for our winter season. The contracts we will have with the dome are being legally reviewed. We have submitted our request for hours and 90% of them have been secured. The other 10% will be secured just working out the timing.

- 2. Father's Day Cup: Items for review/improvement for next year's tournament. Items discussed included: team placement, weather communication, registration updates, scoring and use of got soccer.
- 3. Club discipline: We discussed how the board handles discipline issues. Going forward, we will make sure accused families will have a chance at input/feedback before actions are taken by the board. We are also going to start a Sideline Project Program that will require parents to take an on line course before their kids can play in the club.
- 4. Rec Program and unused ref fees: We had a major shortage of refs for rec league. We are working on seting up local special training for refs for the rec league, The board has decided to use the unused funds to supply a soccer ball for all kids that sign up for the rec league this next year in hopes of increasing our enrollment. We will also provide ref shirts for the above mentioned program.
- 5. Michaud re-paving: Starts August 1sta nd will continue through Spetember 17th. We are organizing our first two weeks to be mostly away games to accommodate this situation.
- 6. Balls Kids for High School Games: Chad to take on the communication and organization. Teams will have the opportunity to be ball kids at the high school games.
- 7. Board Member without active members: Both Dave and Eric will no llonger have active children in the program. They have both said they will serve until the annual board meeting. We are looking for applicants for the President and Treasurer positions.

D. Contractors Needs/Updates

1. Director of Coaching

- a. LSC had the best TCSL Record to date. 189 wins, 153 losses, and 58 ties. 27 out of the 56 teams finished in the top 3. Retention for try outs were excellent.
- b.Summer camps were very successful. We had 494 registrants which was more than double the number of last year.
- c.MYSA still not where they need to be so we will stay with TCSL for the next season. NPL league went well. We were very competitive.
- D. Coach retention for this next year was great. We will need to replace three positions.
- E. We have added 5 additional teams to the U9-U12 divisions for the fall.
