Approve: July minutes - Jason Ciocca motioned to approve and Alicia Mosteller seconded. Minutes approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT - Lindsay Wright

1. 2025 Travel Baseball/Softball Budgets – All budgets have been finalized.
2. Fund Carryover – Any remaining 2025 funds will carry over to 2026 unless otherwise specified.
3. 2026 Budget Sheets – Not yet started. I need to connect with the travel directors to confirm teams for both baseball and softball, and once finalized, the sheets will be shared along with each team's final cost-per-player.
 - a. Have final player costs been decided for travel?
4. Insurance paid in full through August 2026.
5. I have not yet received our tax bill. I followed up and learned that the person I had been working with is no longer with the organization. I've forwarded my previous correspondence to the individual now handling her accounts and will continue to follow up until this is resolved.
6. No large outstanding checks. For the most part, everything is reconciled through the last week or so.
7. Overall registration is up 8.6% compared to last year.
