BLUE EAGLES BASKETBALL (BEB) BASKETBALL CODE OF CONDUCT 2015/2016 WINTER & SUMMER BASKETBALL

As a member of the CBL (Community Basketball League), (BEB) supports the CBL philosophy of players, coaches, officials, and fans carrying out their respective roles. However, each organization can enforce their particular code of conduct in any matter they see fit, on a case-by-case basis. We have created the (BEB) Basketball Code of Conduct that is loosely based upon the CBL Code of Conduct. This policy applies to all CBL and (BEB) basketball events, including games and practices, both home, away, or at neutral court locations.

To be as concise and clear as possible, (BEB) Basketball will not tolerate any misconduct on the part of any player, coach, or fan. For our purposes "fan" is a parent or any spectator at a CBL contest. Parents of players are responsible for the behavior of any guest they bring to a game.

The (BEB) Basketball Board is the sole judge of what "misconduct" is, and our determinations are final. Any alleged act of misconduct reported by the CBL to our board will be reviewed and any actions will be at our sole discretion. Some obvious examples of misconduct are verbal or physical abuse of any of the game's participants, or other fans. Also, at random times during the season any (BEB) basketball board member may be in attendance at any particular game, and if in their judgment a particular action requires a review by the board of directors; it shall be done as quickly as possible. Decisions may be appealed to the full board of Blue Eagles Basketball, which oversees all community basketball programs throughout the Nazareth Vicinity.

Possible consequences for misconduct may include, but are not limited to, verbal warnings, dismissal from coaching or other participation for the balance of a season or in an extreme circumstance, permanent expulsion from any participation in our program.

We sincerely believe our community is above any sort of the examples of misconduct as previously mentioned, but be advised the board has unanimously agreed to a zero tolerance policy for any such behavior. And, again to be clear, the board's decisions are final.
