A Letter from Leah's Family: Soccer Tournament History

The Leah Fenney Memorial Soccer Tournament started in Fall 1992 to remember 6-year-old Leah Fenney, a member of the Erin Soccer Club who died on March 4, 1992, from a sudden coronary heart disease. Rain or shine, the Fenney Family ran the tournament annually until the Fall 2003. The family donated the proceeds of the tournament to the local Kettle Moraine Soccer League for camps, events, or equipment needs--including defibrillators to the soccer clubs. Since then, Erin Soccer Club has graciously put on the tournament and has continued to build it into the huge success it is today--keeping the tradition alive for more than 30 years. This tournament and the support it generates means so much to Leah's family as it has kept her memory alive in our community since her passing. The purpose of the tournament was always to pay tribute to Leah's favorite activity by encouraging children's participation in soccer at young ages, but more importantly to celebrate the joy, laughter, and positivity the sport brings to people of all ages.

Over the years, thousands of community volunteers--coaches, referees, and parents--have contributed to the success of the Leah Fenney Memorial Soccer Tournament and have allowed it to become a permanent staple in the area. Its success is also attributed to the hundreds of local businesses that have donated money, equipment, and raffle prizes over the past three decades. The tournament also serves as a great opportunity to bring together soccer clubs in the surrounding area to participate in a day of friendly competition. A big thank you to all of the clubs that have continued to participate year after year.

Leah is the daughter of Dan Fenney and Kathi Wendorff. She is survived by her brother Bryan Fenney and sisters Alivia Cronin and Jordan Dombrowski. All three of her siblings attended Erin School and played Erin Soccer from U-6 to U-14. Most of Leah's family members remain local and enjoy watching a new generation of her relatives playing in the tournament.

Team Registration and General Participation Rules

1. Only teams who have timely registered for the tournament and timely paid their registration fees will be allowed to play in the tournament.
2. All coaches must check in at the registration tent prior to their teams' first games. The registration tent will be located in a large yellow tent near our Snack Shack, located north of field 1 in the center of the soccer field area (field map is included below, on page 11).
3. All players must wear consistent uniforms for their team, including matching colored shorts and socks. Players without matching uniforms may be excluded from play.
4. Any team personnel or spectators who verbally abuse any referees or players may be subject to immediate ejection and banishment from the tournament.
5. Coaches should use open, off-field areas for pre-game warm-ups in order to ensure games run on schedule.

Tournament Scoring

6. The tournament is structured with initial "pool" (also known as "group") stage play, followed by championship play. Each team will play two pool play games. Pool play scoring will go as follows:
 - 3 points for a win
 - 1 point for a tie
 - 0 points for a loss
7. At the end of pool play, the teams with the most points from pool play will advance to championship play. The number of teams advancing per each age division is as follows:
 - U7 - Top 4 teams advance
 - U8 - Top 4 teams advance
 - U9 - Top 4 teams advance
 - U10 - Top 4 teams advance
 - U10 Girls - Top 2 teams advance
8. In the case of multiple teams in the same division with the same amount of pool play points, the following tie breakers will be used in order:
 1. Goal differential (goals scored minus goals conceded)
 2. Fewest goals conceded
 3. Most goals scored
 4. Fewest yellow/red cards
 5. Coin flip
9. Tournament standings will be updated using an online spreadsheet throughout the day. The spreadsheet is accessible using this link: [📄 2025 TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE](#) . This will also be accessible via a QR code located in the registration tent. The standings for

each division are situated on separate tabs of the spreadsheet. Standings will live update after scores are entered into the spreadsheet from the referees' score cards.

10. In the event a team forfeits before or during a game, the non-forfeiting team will be awarded a win either with a 3-0 score or the score at the time of the forfeit, whichever is more advantageous for the non-forfeiting team.
11. In championship play, if a U7/U8 game ends in a tie both teams will play for a "golden goal," also known as "next goal wins." A coin-flip will take place, with Team 2 acting as the visiting team (calling the coin flip). Play will continue until the next goal is scored. If no goal is scored after 10 minutes, the referee will pause play and ask each team to remove a player from the field. This continues until a goal is scored. At that time, the game will end.
12. In championship play, if a U9/U10/U10 Girls game ends in a tie, the game will be decided with "Kicks from the Mark" (i.e., penalty kick shootout) according to standard FIFA guidelines. Only players on the field at the end of regulation will be permitted to participate in the shootout. Each team will alternate kicks (five each) to decide the champion. If still tied after the first round of five shots, teams will alternate 1 for 1 until the game is decided. A player can only make a second kick after all teammates on the field at the end of regulation have taken a turn.

Game Rules

13. The Kettle Moraine Soccer League (KMSL) rules (based on the FIFA Laws of the Game) will apply to all games, except for the following modifications for Tournament Play.
14. Referees will perform typical pre-game inspections with both teams to ensure that all players are fit to play (i.e., wearing proper footwear, equipped with shin guards, are not wearing jewelry, etc.). Band-aids used to cover earrings are not allowed. Permanent bracelets are also not allowed.

Tournament modifications: There will **NOT be a pre-game coin flip for initial possession. The team designated as the **"AWAY"** team for the game will **kick off** in the **First and Second Quarters**. Teams will defend the goal nearest the bench they choose to begin the game. The team designated as the **"HOME"** team will **provide the game ball**.
15. In the event of two teams playing each other with similar color jerseys, the team designated as the Home team for the game is responsible for providing and wearing pinnies of a contrasting color for the duration of the game.
16. **U7/U8** games are **four (4) 10-minute quarters** with **1-minute quarter breaks** and a **2-minute half time**.
17. **U9/U10/U10 Girls** games are **four (4) 12-minute quarters** with **1-minute quarter breaks** and a **2-minute half time**.

18. At the conclusion of the game, the Referee will approach coaches from each Team to have them initial the official score card. **The referee's decisions in the game are final.**
19. In the event of thunder is heard or lightning is seen during the tournament, games are to be suspended and everyone is to leave the fields and seek shelter in cars or buildings (not merely under pavilions) until 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder or sight of lightning. Lightning can travel 10 miles from a storm, and thunder can be heard from 10 miles away. You will be notified by Tournament Officials should this occur.

General Rules for Spectators and Team Personnel

20. Spectators are to sit at least 6 feet away from the sidelines and corner flags to allow room for play.
21. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed or allowed near the playing area.
22. Smoking and vaping are not allowed near the playing area.
23. ****UNRULY AND DISRESPECTFUL SPECTATORS OR COACHES WILL BE ESCORTED FROM THE TOURNAMENT IMMEDIATELY AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RETURN**** This also includes any players or coaches issued a RED card during game play.

Please remember:

- ❖ These are kids.
- ❖ This is a game.
- ❖ The coaches are volunteers.
- ❖ The referees are human.
- ❖ This is not the World Cup.

Other Information:

- Families are encouraged to bring pop-up tents for shelter from rain/sun.
- Some fields do not have bleachers for fans. Please bring chairs, blankets, etc.
- Concessions will be open all day and will provide typical items like hot dogs, burgers, chips, candy, sports drinks, water, donuts, coffee and hot chocolate.
- A limited supply of Leah Fenney Tournament winter hats will be for sale at the concession stand.
- Cash (preferred), and Credit/Debit Cards will be accepted as payment for concessions.
- Each player will receive a participation medal and a Leah Fenney Tournament water bottle.
- Trophies will be awarded to each player on the winning Championship Team for

each age division.

Parking Map - Overview

Parking is available where indicated with red arrows, and traffic must flow in the direction of the arrows. Where indicated with a circle and red X, no through traffic is allowed. 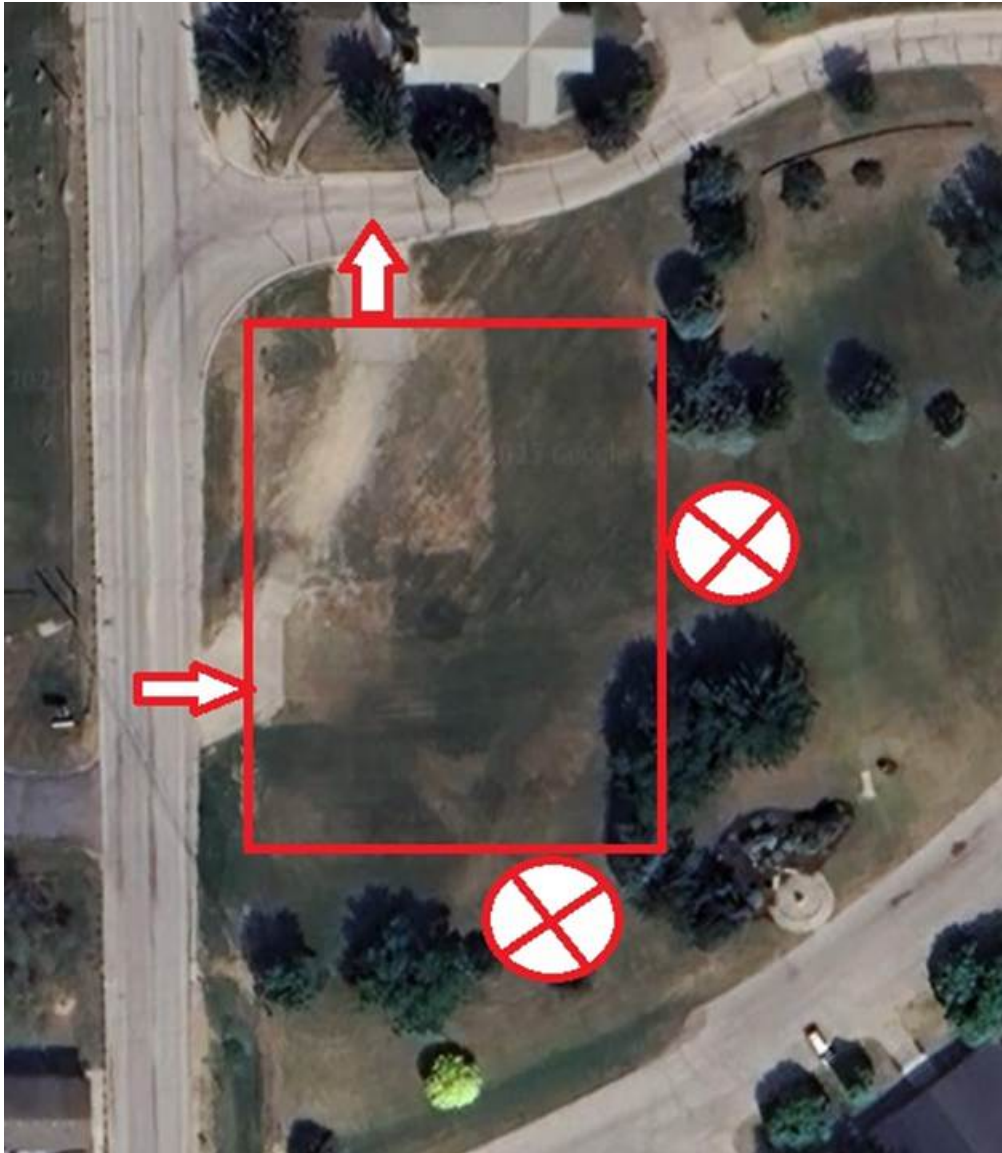
Parking Map - St. Patrick Lane Area

Starting from the North, parking will be available North of St. Patrick Lane by entering in the East entrance to the church parking lot and proceeding into the grass and gravel areas, indicated in the red rectangle. (The items shown taking up space in the picture are not currently there.) Please do not use the West entrance to this lot or the area immediately to the North of the West entrance. There will also be parallel parking along the South side of St. Patrick Lane, as indicated by the smaller narrower red rectangle below.



Parking Map - East of Hwy. 83 and South of St. Patrick Lane

Parking is available on the grassy area at the corner that is East of Highway 83 and South of St. Patrick Lane, as indicated by the red rectangle below. Enter this lot from Highway 83 and rows will develop along the edges of the area before rows are formed in the middle of the area. It is not allowed to drive through the trees in the areas indicated with red circles with X's. Exit this lot onto St. Patrick Lane.



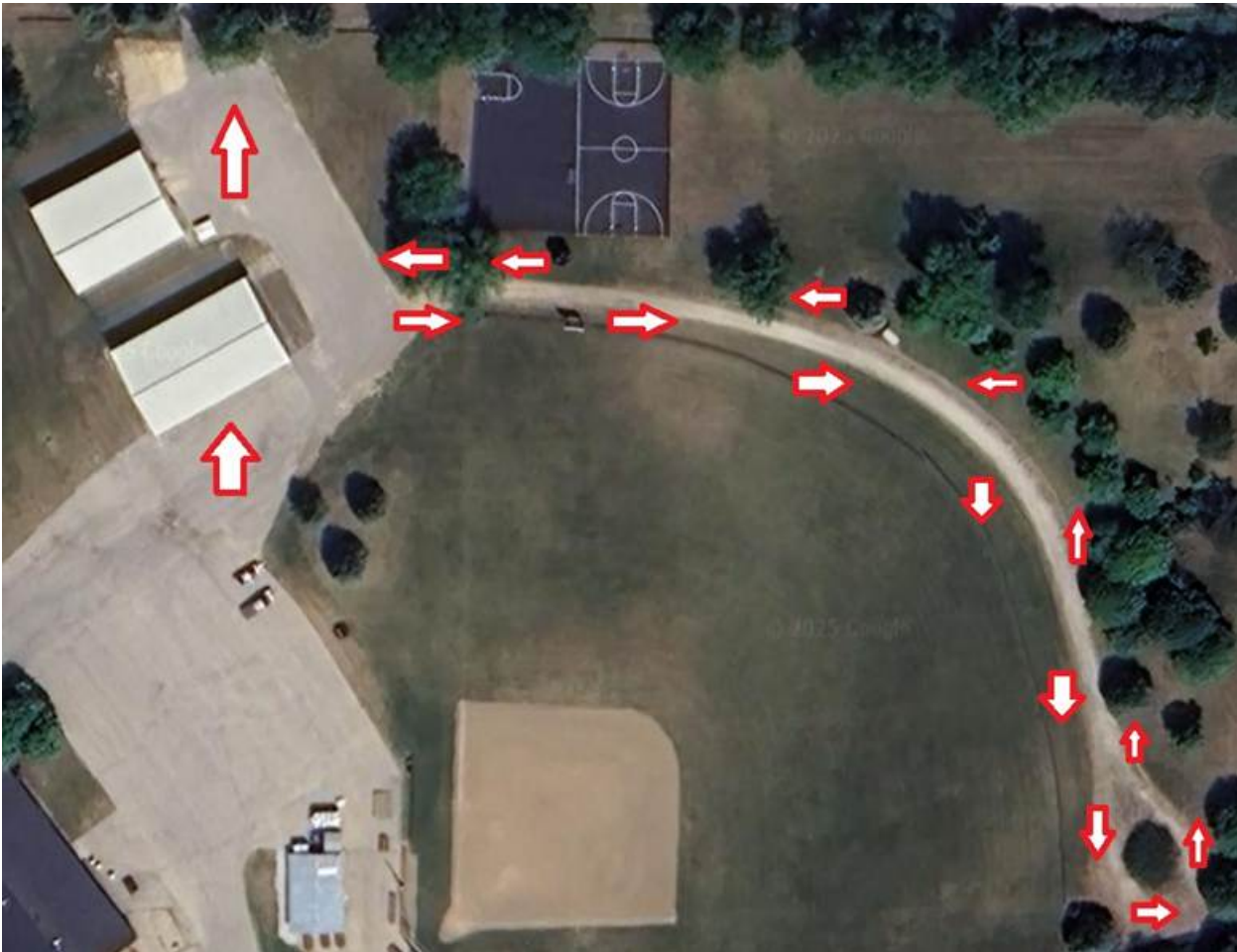
Parking Map - Erin Town Hall Area

Parking is available all around the Erin Town Hall. Enter from Highway 83. Traffic must proceed to the right around the Town Hall building. Parking will be available all around the building, but traffic must flow in a counter-clockwise direction, and no traffic may go through to exit toward Highway 83, as indicated by the red circle with X. Exit from this lot is to the North, toward St. Patrick Lane. Also, no traffic is allowed to go past the baseball pavilion, as indicated by the red circle with X. In addition, the South side of the Town Hall building contains garage doors, and no parking will be allowed that blocks those garage doors. Handicap parking will be designated in this lot.



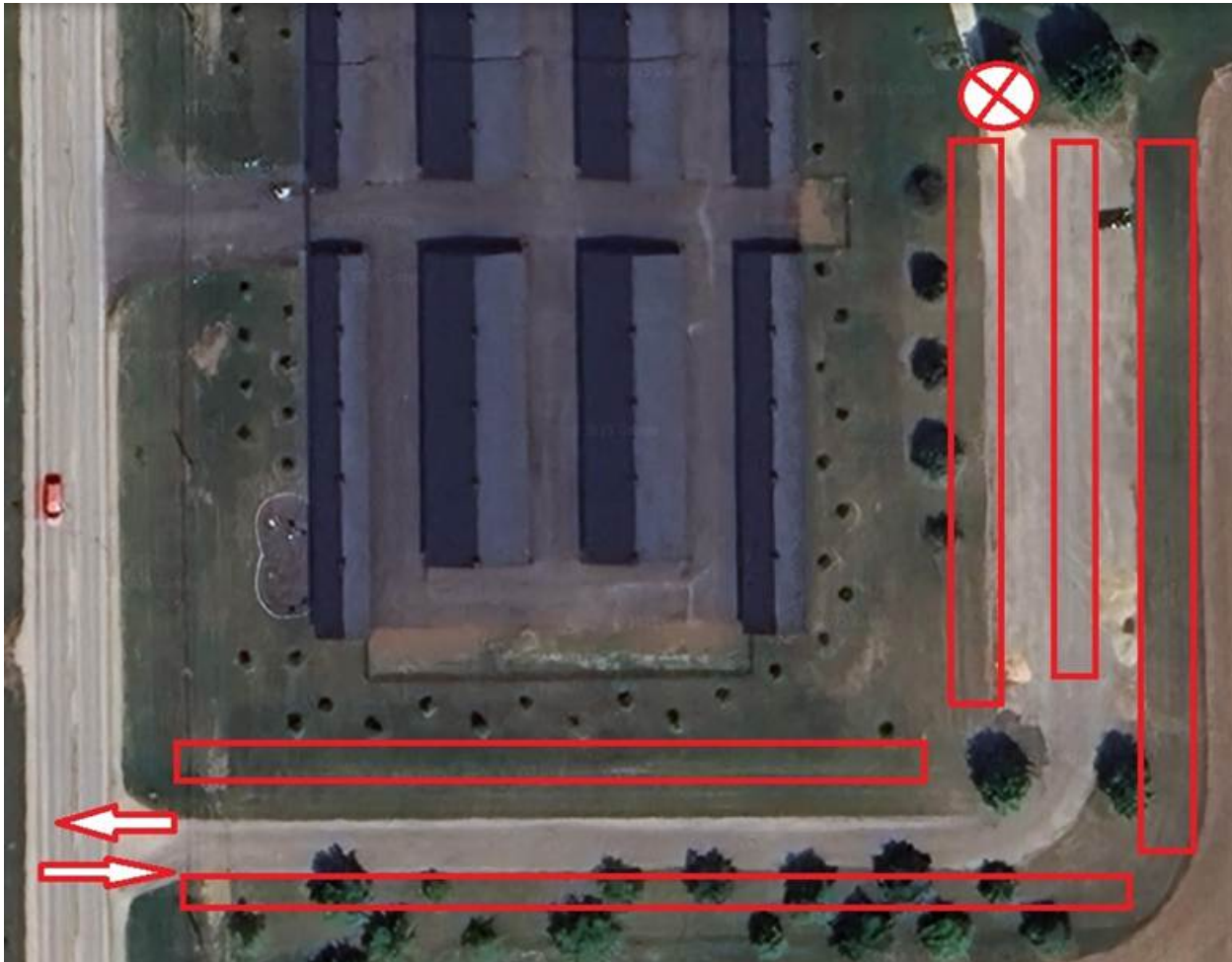
Parking Map - Behind Baseball Outfield

Coming North from the Town Hall parking lot, there is an option to park *behind* the baseball outfield, along the gravel drive there. Parking is *not* allowed *on* the baseball field itself. To park along the gravel drive outside the outfield fence, traffic must proceed all the way to the end of the drive, turn around, and then proceed all the way back toward the parking lot, and vehicles should pull into the grass to the right of the gravel drive. Parking will also be available to the East of the sheds depicted in the below photograph. Exit this area to the North onto St. Patrick Lane.



Parking Map - South Parking Lot

On the far South end of the soccer fields, behind Lucky Hills Storage, there is an additional parking lot. Two-way traffic enters and exits from Highway 83. To maximize this space, vehicles should pull into the grass off each edge of the lot. This will allow a row of parking to form in the middle of this lot. Vehicles should also pull into the grass along the gravel drive that leads to this lot. All parking areas in this lot are indicated with red rectangles. No traffic is allowed to the North of this parking lot along the narrow gravel drive that proceeds next to the soccer fields. Violators will be ticketed. Handicap parking will be designated in this lot.



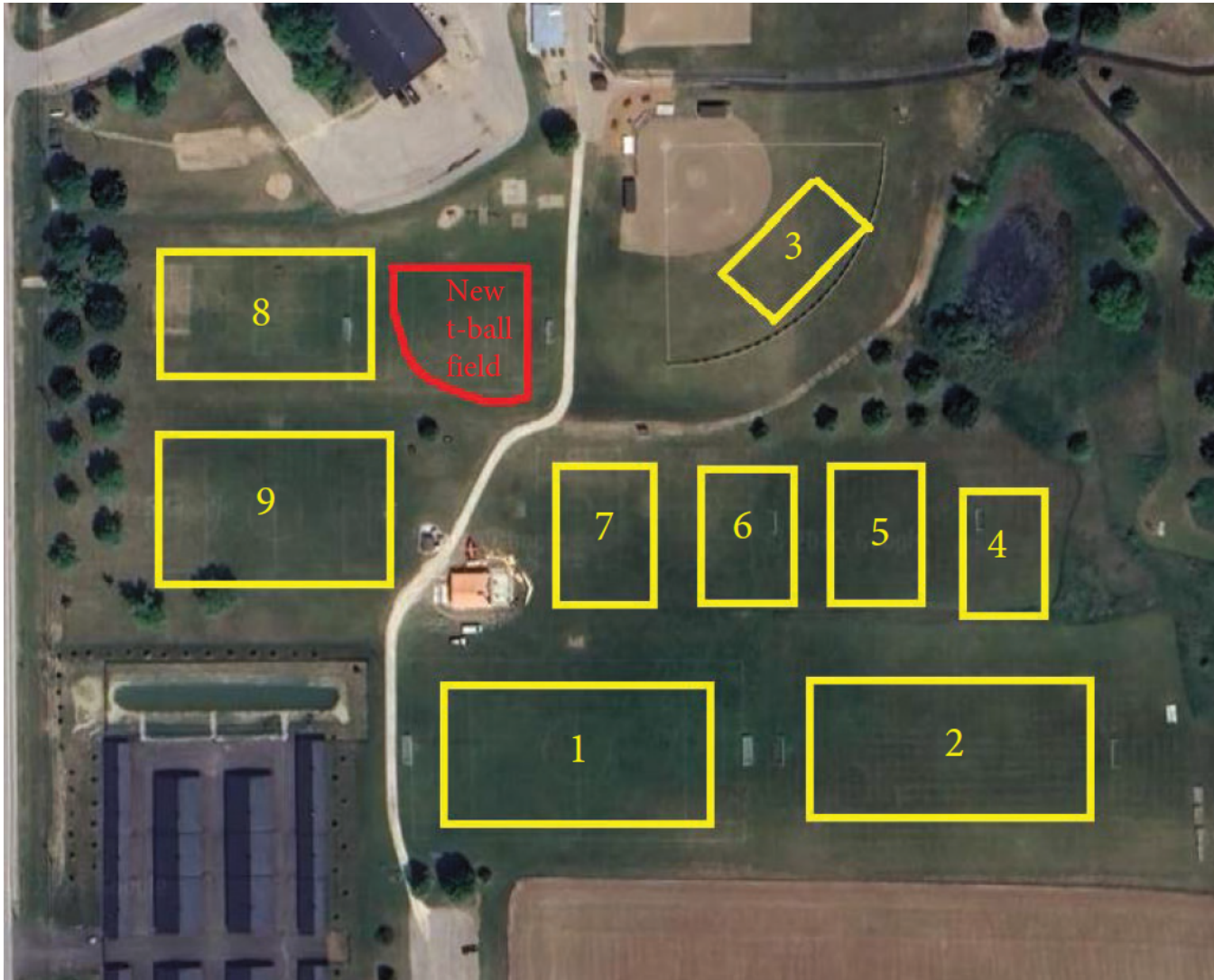
Additional Parking on Hwy. 83

Parallel parking will also be allowed along Highway 83, except for portions indicated with no parking signs (generally, the 50 feet or so near lot entrances).

No tournament parking is allowed in any of the businesses' parking lots along the West side of Highway 83.
