Player / Parent Code of Conduct

This code of conduct has been approved by the PVNLL Board of Directors. Bad behavior will not be tolerated in our league. All players and parents are required to read and sign this code. In doing so you will be acknowledging that you agree to comply with the code as it is written. Any infractions will be taken before the Board of Directors for resolution. This could result in expulsion from the league, if warranted. The following Code of Conduct will pertain to all parents, players, league officials, umpires, and spectators.

- 1. There will be no profane, vulgar or obscene language by any representative of the league, any parent, any player at any time, for any reason.
- 2. There will be no gambling or betting in our facilities or on the outcome of any games, at any time.
- 3. There will be no physical confrontations or attack or threats of attacks, against any player, parent, spectator, coach, manager, umpire, official or board member.
- 4. There will be no unnecessary rough play against any player on another team during the course of the game.
- 5. There will be no obnoxious, objectionable displays of anger at any umpire's decision or call, including but not limited to the throwing of equipment (hats, bats, balls, gloves, or helmets), swearing, yelling, kicking, or physical confrontation.
- 6. Verbal abuse of officials by players, parents, spectators, coaches, managers, or league officials, WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!
- 7. No one may, at any time, strike, push, poke, hit, spit on, or threaten any league official, player, coach, manager, or umpire.
- 8. There will be a zero tolerance for anyone showing up at our fields under the influence of alcohol or drugs. "Intoxicated" will be determined by an objectionable behavior, or odor of alcohol. Authorities will be called.
- 9. No one may make loud, derogatory comments about any umpire, player, coach, or manager, or about any call made by any umpire with which there is a disagreement.
- 10. Umpires will not be challenged. Umpires have the right and the authority to discipline any offender, including having them removed from the park, or league facilities.
- 11. No alcohol is permitted at our park.
- There will be no manipulation of any league rulebooks, rosters, scorebooks, or schedules, by anyone, at any time.

I hereby agree to abide by the PV North Little League Code of Conduct and Safety Code as outlined in the Safety Manual. I understand that failure to behave in a responsible and respectful manner may result in the expulsion from the league. (Provide a copy of the signed form to PVNLL Officials).
