GENERAL LEAGUE

- **Net Size**

- Low-Impact is set at Junior Height.
- Jr. High and High School are set at Women's Height.

- **Scoring and Gameplay**

- Each regular season match will consist of two full sets, and one abbreviated set. There will always be THREE sets.
 - The first and second sets are to 25 points.
 - Third set is abbreviated to 15 points.
 - All sets the team must win by 2 points.
- Tournament matches are three abbreviated sets.

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ROTATIONS

ALL OUT VOLLEYBALL IS A FAIR PLAY LEAGUE.


LOW IMPACT: EVERY PLAYER ROTATES CLOCKWISE ONCE THEIR TEAM WINS BACK THE SERVE. (ALL PLAYERS MUST ROTATE OUT WHEN IT IS THEIR TURN).

JUNIOR HIGH: EVERY PLAYERS ROTATES CLOCKWISE ONCE THEIR TEAM WINS BACK THE SERVE. (ALL PLAYERS MUST ROTATE OUT WHEN IT IS THEIR TURN).

HIGH SCHOOL: EVERY PLAYER ROTATES CLOCKWISE ONCE THEIR TEAM WINS BACK THE SERVE. (ALL PLAYERS ROTATE OUT EXCEPT FOR 1 OR 2 SELECTED BY THE COACH AND VERIFIED BY THE REF).

AT EACH LEVEL EVERY PLAYER WILL RECEIVE PLAYING TIME IN EACH SET.
WE CAN NOT PROMISE EQUAL PLAYING TIME BUT WE CAN MAKE IT AS
FAIR AS POSSIBLE.

SERVING


ALL OUT VOLLEYBALL IS COMMITTED TO GIVING PLAYERS A FAIR CHANCE AT SERVING.

LOW IMPACT: PLAYERS WILL SERVE FROM THE MODIFIED SERVING LINE, IF THEY CHOOSE THEY CAN SERVE FROM STANDARD SERVING LINE. THEY MAY SERVE UNDERHAND OR OVERHAND. PLAYERS WILL RECEIVE TWO CHANCES TO SERVE THE BALL OVER THE NET. IF THE BALL DOES NOT GO OVER THE TEAMS COACH WILL TOSS A BALL IN FOR THE OPPOSING TEAM.

JUNIOR HIGH: PLAYERS WILL SERVE FROM THE STANDARD SERVING LINE. THEY MUST SERVE OVERHAND ON THEIR FIRST TRY, IF THEY MISS THEY WILL BE GRANTED A SECOND TRY. THEY MUST STAY AT THE STANDARD SERVING LINE FOR THE SECOND ATTEMPT. HOWEVER, THEY CAN SERVE UNDERHAND IF NEEDED.

HIGH SCHOOL: PLAYERS WILL SERVE FROM THE STANDARD SERVING LINE AND GIVEN ONE OPPORTUNITY. THEY MUST SERVE OVERHAND.

Serving lines:



LOW IMPACT AND JUNIOR HIGH: SERVING RUNS CAPPED AT 5 POINTS
 HIGH SCHOOL: SERVING RUNS CAPPED AT 10 POINTS.
 ALL LEAGUES WILL ROTATE A NEW SERVER AFTER THE CAP IS MET. THE BALL DOES NOT GO TO THE OPPOSING TEAM.

COACH EXPECTATIONS

COACHES VOLUNTEER FOR THEIR POSITION AND ARE CHOSEN BY THE ALL OUT VOLLEYBALL STAFF.

ALL OUT VOLLEYBALL COACHES ARE EXPECTED TO...

- ADHERE TO THE RULES OF THE LEAGUE
 - GIVE EACH PLAYER A FAIR OPPORTUNITY
 - REFLECT A CHRIST-LIKE CHARACTER
 - ACT WITH RESPECT AND PROFESSIONALISM
 - BE A POSITIVE ROLE MODEL
 - PROMOTE SPORTSMANSHIP AND HARDWORK
 - ENSURE PLAYER SAFETY AND WELL-BEING
 - COMMUNICATE EFFECTIVELY
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IN THE SAME WAY WE HAVE SET EXPECTATIONS FOR OUR ATHLETES (SEE NEXT PAGE). WE ALSO HAVE SET EXPECTATIONS FOR OUR COACHES.

IF THERE IS EVER A MOMENT YOU FEEL THE COACHES ARE NOT UPHOLDING THESE EXPECTATIONS, PLEASE REACH OUT. RESPECT THE 24 HOUR RULE, MEANING YOU WILL WAIT 24 HOURS TO THINK BEFORE REACHING OUT. WE ASK THAT YOU PLEASE HAVE A CONVERSATION WITH THE COACH BEFORE REACHING OUT TO THE COORDINATORS. COORDINATORS ARE HIRED TO HELP RUN THE PROGRAM, WHICH MEANS THEY ARE BUSY. IF SOMEONE IS IN HARM, A CONSISTENT ISSUE IS NOT BEING RESOLVED, OR YOU JUST HAVE QUESTIONS REACH OUT TO THEM. THERE IS CONTACT INFORMATION ON PAGE 6. THANK YOU!
