ABOUT US

The Chicago Inter South is a non-profit organization founded in 2014 for the purpose of promoting soccer for youth in Bloomington-Normal and surrounding areas. Our philosophy and mission is to provide a soccer program "where soccer and the players can grow".

Our focus is to build both the mental and physical skills of the game, preparing our youth to be leaders both on and off the field.

WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT

Chicago Inter South believes that "...the best teacher of the game of soccer is the game itself..." Simply put, children get better at soccer by playing, playing and playing some more. We also believe well-trained, resourceful coaches will enhance a child's enjoyment of this beautiful sport by creating a soccer environment which focuses on productive and economical play.

We offer a competitive select program for the youth athlete who wants a more serious, intense soccer program. The most successful youth teams throughout the world all receive regular well planned training sessions which follow our consistent philosophy to develop players.

Our programs are structured in such a way to cover age specific training goals and progress a team's development over the course of the season. During a season the programs cover the fundamental team and individual skills specifically required for any age group. We will work on technical, tactical and age-appropriate fitness elements.

TRYOUT INFORMATION

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR AT TRYOUTS?

Present and potential Chicago Inter South Team players are evaluated in four general areas:

Psychological Qualities

At Chicago Inter South we believe that attitude is the most essential quality for the success of any player. We assess a player's self-motivation, training ethic and desire to become a competitive soccer player. Moreover, in considering the overall dynamic of the team, we evaluate a player's level of sportsmanship, leadership and the ability to take instruction.

Technical Qualities

Technical qualities include such skills as: first touch, dribbling, passing, juggling, etc. We do not place as significant an emphasis on this component, especially at the U6-8 ages. That is what we are for! General athleticism is beneficial, but not essential at this stage. What is important, however, is that a player enjoys physical activity and is trying out for his or her own reasons.

Tactical Knowledge

Tactical knowledge refers to a players' understanding the game of soccer and the ability to make effective decisions as a result of that understanding. Again, we do not place as big an emphasis on tactical understanding at the younger ages. All we generally look for in this area is the responsiveness of a player to tactical instruction.

Technical Qualities

Technical qualities include a player's strength, speed and agility. We do not place much weight on this component for our team selections at the youth levels, as there are many variables that influence a player's physical development. Our aim is to provide each player with the technical skill and tactical understanding of the game necessary to nullify the effect of physical variations at the younger ages.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER TRYOUTS?

After tryouts conclude, coaches will meet on 6/3/2022 to evaluate players and form teams.

What if my child is selected?

If your child was selected to join Chicago Inter South, you will receive an email by 6/5/2021. You will be asked to accept or decline the offer that day. At the same time, you will be asked to submit club fees.

Once we receive notification of your commitment and club fees, your child will be added to the team roster. You will receive detailed information from your coach or team manager about the next steps (i.e., uniform orders, picking tournaments, practice schedules, follow-up regarding any additional player paperwork needed for player cards) before the fall season begins.

What if my child does not make a team?

If your child does not make a team, you may be offered a "training player" position. Training players will practice with the team, but will not be eligible to play in tournaments. Training player fees vary per age.

How long do I have to wait to commit?

We respect families' decisions and will not call/email multiple times to convince families to play for our club. We want to make sure that our players and families are with us because its a good fit.

COMMITMENT & COMPETITIVENESS

Player's Commitment

Players selected onto a Chicago Inter South team are expected to commit to training at the highest level. Chicago Inter South is premised on the philosophy of competition in all aspects of its players' development.

Parents' Commitment

Parents of Chicago Inter South team players must understand and be in support of the Chicago Inter South objectives for their child. It is important to recognize that players and parents must invest significant time and resources into their child's training schedule. In addition, we require parents to volunteer four hours per season per child to help with club activities and improvements.



ABOUT SK NORD



S.K. Nord Fields were developed in 1995 on 18 acres of land owned by Dr. Stanley K. Nord. After an initial investment of \$5,000 from the Nord family, David Stark, owner of Stark Excavating, donated the use of earth moving equipment to help level the playing surface. Ed Lee of Paletine's Summit Seed Company donated bluegrass seed at cost. Mike Smith donated his time to plant the seed. Mike Hilgenbrink donated time for soil testing. Warren Elgin of Danvers provided the fertilizing. It was truly a community effort that brought this project to life.

Twenty-one years after becoming one of the first soccer complexes in Bloomington-Normal, S.K. Nord Fields stands as a testament to the difference volunteers can make. Chicago Inter South has continued the tradition, partnering with volunteers, businesses and families to make sure the fields remain a place where soccer and the players can grow.

The names may have changed, but the generosity of the community has allowed us to further this tradition.
