Church Rules

As a reminder, we are renting our fields from the church. Please show respect when at our fields, and abide by the following church rules:

- ☀ No parking in grass or on the driveway. The driveway should only be used to pick up or drop off players, not as a permanent parking spot.

In addition, the field should not be used out of practice times and club events. We (MFC) are liable for any accidents that occur on these fields, especially around soccer goals. We also request that players do NOT hang on the goals.
