McIntire Little League Majors teams play approximately 18 to 20 regular season games with an average of two games per week. In addition to the games, most Majors managers practice an additional two days per week during the regular season and potentially more frequently before the games begin. McIntire Little League is governed by Little League International. There are many rules in Little League that all Managers must familiarize themselves with before the season begins. We will ask all our Managers to read the current Little League Rule Book so that they are clear on the various rules that will govern McIntire Little League. There are additional training resources available should you be interested, but a thorough understanding of the Little League Rule Book is a necessity for all Majors managers.
