

Thank you for volunteering! We appreciate your willingness to assist in making this an enjoyable and successful tournament experience for all players and spectators!

Please report to the tournament headquarters about 10 minutes prior to your shift start time to receive your field assignment and any game cards, vest, radio, etc.

As a field marshal you will assist the tournament director in the following ways:

1. Scan the field for any issues before and during the games.
 - a. Make sure nets, corner flags, and goals are securely in place
 - b. Make sure all spectators are behind the spectator line or at least 3ft from the side lines
 - c. No spectators are allowed behind the goals or on the team bench side lines
 - d. Verify all referees are present as well as both teams

If any of the above presents an issue, please contact the tournament director!

2. During the game
 - a. Monitor the game for injuries requiring a trainer – ** the ref or coach will make this decision and alert you **
 - b. Monitor the game for any issues, unruly spectators or coaches
 - c. Periodically walk the sidelines to observe and maintain the spectator side lines
 - d. Pick up and dispose of any trash lying around, call if trash cans need servicing
 - e. Contact the tournament director if the game falls behind schedule for any injuries, long delays, or goes into penalty kicks

If any of the above presents an issue, please contact the tournament director!

3. After the game
 - a. Take the score card to the center ref
 - i. They will fill out the scores, **Please confirm what they write down and make sure it is legible **
 - b. If it is a final have at least the losing coach initial the score if possible, especially in a contentious game
 - c. Gently remind teams to clean their bench space and to pick up trash before leaving
 - d. Return score cards to the headquarters tent – ** this is very important for the last day of games as finals and trophies depend on score cards coming in promptly
 - e. Scan the field again for trash

If any of the above presents an issue, please contact the tournament director!

Some things that are helpful to bring with you:

Dress appropriately for the weather and have something on hand for rain as well as sunscreen!

Make sure you have comfortable and appropriate footwear.

We normally have water on hand, but it is best to bring your own water bottle and snacks.

An extra pen or thin marker as they are easily lost.
