

Junior Baseball Organization, Inc. Minutes Board of Commissioners Meeting September 11, 2022, 1:00, Work Session and Board Meeting

Work Session and Board Meeting called to order at 1:00pm by Jay Faxon

Work Session

Matrix discussion

5A schools with 3 teams who have to have a federal team, their American teams are getting killed. Suggest 1 federal and 2 national. Smaller organizations who sometimes have 1 team, sometimes 2 teams (so 1 Amer. and 1 Nat) and they struggle to compete. Can we go case by case to make exceptions? On a whole, people are happy with playing the matrix or not going to post-season.

4A schools 1 fed 1amer 2 nat, maybe should have 1 fed and 3 nat because amer teams can't compete

Should we look at hs level 6A, 5A, 4A etc or look at the programs and make adjustments?

Right now, 6A can put in to play down a level for 2 years.

Worse thing we did for years was to let teams play down and still go to state. Can't make exceptions for schools that don't have a good program. They need to build their program up and recruit kids to play.

6A wins fed, 4A wins amer, 3A/2A wins nat...5A are in a quandary.

Think about it—bring suggestions to next meeting.

Rule actually says "If an Association is unwilling to play by the matrix or complete the reclassification section of the JBO Application and get District approval, yet still wants to play below the matrix then they forgo post-season play (**District and JBO**)." Rule Section H and I---teams should not tell dcs where they are going to play. DCs should put the team where they feel they best fit.

Pitch Count

State count should be per day. No difference between pitching 60 and 35 or 40 and 55? What if pitches 80, then 15 later in day with all of the warm-up pitches.

95 in day 1, 30 pitches left for a total of 125. Stupid simple. No days of rest? Arm health, keep days of rest. You get 125, use it how you want. Submit total at each game. Too many examples—if we have to do a supplemental worksheet to support the rule it means we need to fix it.

League? Change Juniors because they are exactly the same as Minors. Juniors 1-25, 26-40, etc. can't throw 3 straight days? Why can't a kid close 3 days in a row? With rainouts at end of season 30-30-30 is sometimes necessary.

Consensus is to leave it alone. Take back to districts for a discussion.

Rule Schedule Rule proposal chain: a person submits a proposal to a District. District discusses and

votes on it. If approved, DCs email it to the JBO board no later than October 31st. Rule proposal from a JBO Board member: email it to the JBO board no later than

October 31st.

Lynn will compile all of the proposals, create a ballot, and email back to the entire

JBO board no later than November 15th.

DCs take all rule proposals back to Districts for a District vote.

DCs bring those votes to the board meeting in January, and along with the executive

committee, all will submit their votes (ballots).

Team Fees Reminder that team fees are now \$70, up from \$55. How long until a new increase?

Lynn checked prior minutes and there is no timeline in place for another increase.

Sponsorship Wilson contract was up in July 2022. We will pursue both Wilson and

Rawlings/Easton.

Board Positions VP and Secretary are both up for election.
