

Dear Park Ridge Baseball/Softball Parents,

The new Traffic/Bike Lanes on Busse Hwy. have drastically increased the danger to our Park Ridge Baseball/Softball (PRBS) families, when dropping off players and family members at our Hinkley #2 and #3 fields. The PRBS Board has requested and received approval from the City of Park Ridge and IDOT for a **No Parking/Drop Off Zone** at the gate entrances of Hinkley #2 & Hinkley #3.

This will help reduce the danger of personal injury and property damage caused by double parking in the traffic lane to drop off players and family members.

On June 1st, the Park Ridge City Council unanimously approved the Zones during the Committee of the Whole Meeting. The two No Parking/Drop Off Zones will be up for final approval at the June 15th City Council Meeting, then permanent signage will be installed. Effective immediately, the Park Ridge Police will fully enforce the restriction and ticket violators.

When dropping off family members, please pull into either of the **No Parking/Drop Off Zones** and safely drop off your family members at the curb, then immediately leave the Zone. The Zones are big enough for 3 cars.
