- President Report: Richie Anderson announced this is the 1st annual meeting in several years.
 Topics to be covered include:

 - > Problems include scheduling, cost, and available practice fields

- VP Report: Jamison Smith presented a 2023-2024 organizational chart to be voted on: via closed ballots 19 yes and 4 no. The organizational chart passed. The 2023/2023 Constitution was presented for review and to be voted on (this is also posted online for viewing), after discussion, via closed ballot vote 14 yes and 1 no. Constitution passed. Vote for 2 positions of coach coordinators; nominees are Dave Denniston, Henry Simpson, and Jessica Attkisson. After closed ballot votes are as follows; Dave 16 votes, Henry 13 votes, and Jessica 14 votes. The 2 positions will be filled by David Denniston and Jessica Attkisson. Position for Equipment manager needs filled, Billly Irving volunteered, voting via raised hands with majority yes. He will fill the position. There is a fields and grounds crew member position open, no one volunteered
- Richie Anderson opened floor for any questions, discussions, or concerns:
 - Henry Simpson voiced concern for senior league children being able to play all stars if they cannot play during spring season due to school ball.

- Jeremy Pickering voiced concerns about parents not allowing their travel ball pitchers to pitch during LL games, per Jamison, this should be discussed with parents on an individual bases.
- > Mr. Hathaway voiced concern about having more umpires available.
- Ashley Powell announced the holes for concession duty that need to be filled.
 Per Richie, all games should be completed by June 1st for all stars. There are to be a minimum of 12 games per team and each player must attend 8 games minimum to be considered for an all-star team, the exceptions are for senior BB and senior SB.
