President's Report-

- Travel teams are due for declaration by March 1. We asked that PAWest get schedules out as soon as possible as it can potentially force a huge financial burden onto BWSA to rent fields. Typically we don't get schedules until after the permits deadlines have hit so we have to over book and hope that the facility allows us to back out and not pay for the space and time that we are not using.
- Certified referee ages dropped to 13 IF the referee turns 14 within the year. Prices dropped to 45 for a recertification and 65 for an entry level.
- There is a program available called coaching for the community that they will send trainers for coaches. Grassroots certifications will now be required through PAWest. In person is 1 hour lecture, 1 hour on the field. We will schedule it at the high school as MANDATORY. Looking to do it 3/19.
