The following business was discussed:

A. Beasley Camp is the week of June 15 starting at 9:00am. Players can sign up the first morning of camp. KSC is providing the field space.

B. Tryouts:

June 1 and 2 will be scrimmages so coaches can evaluate in game situations.

June 16 and 17 will be tryouts

All registrations are done online for rec and travel fall 2015.

Cost for fall:

**Full travel player: \$250 including one tournament

**Red shirt only: \$75 may participate in all practices, must be invited to participate in games. Not required to purchase uniform.

**Red shirt plus rec: \$100 reserved for academy age. Practices with the academy and assigned to a rec team.

**Split bench: \$100 participates in all practices and assign to half of the games...2 home and 2 away. Designed for those players who aren't going to get lots of playing time in traditional travel and are trying to take the step up to travel.

We will discourage kids from playing rec that are full roster travel players. Deposit of \$75 must be paid before a player is assigned to a team.

C. Rec League:

Pat will have people at the fields on May 29 to help answer registration questions. NYO participating with our league in fall 2015. Also planning to contact Taylor and Tri Central about participation.

Rec games beginning mid-August.
