



This document is meant to help guide parents in determining what division they should register their child in.

BASEBALL and TBALL

For baseball, registration is done by league age as defined [here](#):

Child born between 9/1/2021 and 8/31/2022 (league age 4):

The only division you can register your child in is Tball, per Little League rules. Note, all Tball divisions will be combined (boys and girls)

Child born between 9/1/2018 and 8/31/2021 (league age 5-7):

- If this is your first time playing baseball OR your child is still learning to hit the ball off the batting T OR is still learning to catch the ball and is uncomfortable doing so, register your child for the Tball division
- If your child has played before AND hits the ball regularly off the batting T AND is not afraid of the ball when catching, register your child for A Ball (this is our Coach Pitch division)
- If your child has played before AND catches the baseball regularly, register your child for the Evaluation Division. What division they play in (A, AA, AAA) will be based on where they are chosen by the managers.

Child born between 9/1/2016 and 8/31/2018 (league age 8-9):

- If this is your first time playing baseball and your child has some basic throwing and catching skills, register your child for the Evaluation Division. What division they play in (A, AA, AAA) will be based on where they are chosen by the managers. Feel free to reach out to president@edll.org if you have additional questions.
- If you think your child is not ready to play in a division that uses a hard baseball, or that it might be a safety concern, register your child for the A Ball division. The A Ball division is a Coach Pitch division that uses a soft strike baseball to aid in the child's baseball development.
- Otherwise, register your child in the Evaluation Division. What division they play in (A, AA, AAA, Majors – only league age 9 are eligible per LL rules) will be based on where they are chosen by the managers.

Child born between 9/1/2014 and 8/31/2016 (league age 10-11):

The only division available to register in is the Evaluation division. What division they play in (A, AA, AAA, Major) will be based on where they are chosen by the managers.

Child born between 9/1/2013 and 8/31/2014 (league age 12):

The only division you can register your child in is the Major division, per Little League rules.

Child born between 9/1/2009 and 8/31/2013 (league age 13-16):

The only division you can register your child in is the Senior division.

SOFTBALL and TBALL

For softball, registration is done by league age, which is the same as chronological age as defined [here](#):

Child born in 2021 (league age 4):

The only division you can register your child in is Tball, per Little League rules. Note, all Tball divisions will be combined (boys and girls)

Child born in 2019 or 2020 (league age 5-6)

- If this is your first time playing softball OR your child is still learning to hit the ball off the batting T OR is still learning to catch the ball and is uncomfortable doing so, register your child for the Tball division
- Otherwise, register your child in the Evaluation Division. What division they play in (A, AA, AAA) will be based on where they are chosen by the managers.

Child born between 2014 and 2018 (league age 7-11)

The only division available to register is in the Evaluation division. What division they play in (A, AA, AAA) will be based on where they are chosen by the managers.

Child born in 2013 (league age 12)

The only division you can register your child is the Major division, per Little League rules.

Child born between 2009 and 2012 (league age 13-16)

The only division you can register your child is in the Senior division.
