Short-Term Goals (accomplished by Spring 2024)

10 permanent dugouts added to 4 Sterling Fields and 1 Norfeldt Field

This would include construction of permanent fencing, overhead cover and permanent benches along 1B and 3B sides of the 5 fields.

Our goal is for work to be done in the fall. As these spaces are outside of the field footprint, it should not affect fall football per WH DPW. Justin Andrews (DPW) has pricing based on Fisher Meadow Field in Avon.

Estimated Cost: \$50,000 per field (2 dugouts per field)

WHGSL will explore alternative costs based on FastPitch Nation model



This would eliminate our current expense of \$225 per month for our additional storage at UHaul site. Excess storage at Sterling Field building is utilized by WH Youth Football League.

Estimated Cost: \$4,000 - \$5,000

Larger Permanent Storage unit/small shed at Norfeldt Field

Estimated Cost: \$1,000 - \$2,000

Manual Scoreboards on all 4 Sterling Fields & Norfeldt Field

Similar scoreboard to the WHLL scoreboard at Kennedy Park Estimated Cost: \$1,300 per scoreboard

Another Permanent Batting Cage at Sterling Field

(near Field 4 - corner of Price Blvd/Sidney Ave)

Pitching Area - Dedicated area with 5-7 Pitching Rubbers of all distances
 (35', 40', 43') and permanent Home Plates with High Fence (10' - 12' behind

home plates)

Proposed Items for Town to Address by Spring 2024

Fence at Norfeldt Field along Trout Brook Drive

Would provide protection for spectators and families from heavy traffic on Trout Brook Drive.

Estimated Cost: \$Unknown

- Norfeldt Field Parking not utilizing this parking lot for Celebrate West
 Hartford staging during the height of our season
- Hot Water in the Restrooms at Sterling Field
- Close off Sterling Field from Track Area
 Similar to partitioning at Glover Soccer Park Complex on Flatbush Avenue.
 Space is often used as a dog park and other activities (golf, vandalism).







Mid-Term Goals (3-5 Years)

- Permanent Electric Scoreboard at Norfeldt Field
- Permanent Structure at Norfeldt Field with real Bathrooms, running water,
 electricity, press box and storage plus small scale snack shack.
- Permanent Structure at Sterling Field (second level of existing structure with press box and electric scoreboards attached facing each Field 1 & 2)
- West Hartford Schools, Town and WHGSL work together to fundraise and pursue higher quality, higher compensated coaches at the HS Level (Varsity, JV & Freshman).
- A new Golf Cart or Utility Vehicle at Sterling Field.
- Long-Term Goals (5-10 Years)

Long-Term Goals (5-10 Years)

- Lighting at Norfeldt Field
- Indoor Practice Space like WH Youth Baseball's facility in Bloomfield.

Potential Other Projects

- Temporary outfield fences on the Sterling Fields (1 & 2 to start)
- Fences in place for Spring & Summer seasons and removed before Football
 Season
- Estimated Cost: \$1,500 per Field
