What happens after tryouts?

Someone will call or send an email to either offer your player a place on a team, or to provide feedback about the tryout experience.

Those who accept their team offers will meet the week of May 25th to connect and get to know one another.

OVFA summer break is:

- June 1 – July 19th. Practices start July 20th.

If your team is participating in summer tournaments, coaches and Team Managers will communicate training dates and travel arrangement needs.

What does a Navy, White, or Burgundy team offer mean?

Starting this year, teams are formed by grade level. Any exceptions to the new format will be decided by coaches and club leadership.

Differences in team levels may include level of competition, number of practice sessions per week, and caliber of tournaments attended.

Navy teams offer the highest level of competition. White and Burgundy teams offer more development and different practice and tournament travel schedules.

When does the club season start?

There are two main seasons for U11-U14 play. Fall season is September to January (Navy) or September to November (White and Burgundy), and Spring season is February to April. Games are on weekends and across the state.

- Club play resumes in the Fall.

What does my team assignment mean?

When does the club season start?

Due to the OSAA high school season, players try out in May, participate in summer programming, and then are added to their high school teams in fall. Club training resumes mid-November after the OSAA season
