Rules, Regulations and Guidelines

***All Leagues chartered with Little League International have insurance for the Second Season Training and Development Program**

The Registration Fees are as follows:

\$100 per team (A, Division).

\$150 per team (B, C, Divisions)

\$200 per team (D, Division)

These Fees will cover the cost of:

1. Scheduling the Games
2. Scheduling the Umpires
3. Costs to generate all Paperwork, internet, computer system.

✓ Each team must provide a minimum of 4 game baseballs, 2 game softballs per game.

MacGregor 76cxx for (9 and 11u), MacGregor 76sll for (14u, 16u) or equivalents.

Softballs must be 11" for 10u, 12" for 12u, 14u, 16u, must be game quality balls.

Balls may be available for purchase through District 8.

The Fall Ball Season:

The Season will begin on Saturday, **September 6/7**, and end on **October 4/5, 2025**

There will be a total of 10 games per team, (5 single games in A divisions) weather permitting. It is our intent for division B teams to play back-to-back doubleheaders; however, sometimes this will not be possible due to weather and the number of teams playing within a division. The C and D divisions of baseball will be given an allotted amount of time to use it at there will

Host Sites will be used for the Fall Ball Program, and District 8 will be fully in charge of where the games will be held.

Standard Rules for all Divisions

1. All Divisions will use Continuous or Mandatory Batting Order., **your choice**.
All Divisions will use unlimited Defensive Substitutions.
2. All Divisions will use the 15/10 Run Rule.
3. All Divisions can use players with this year's Little League age.
4. Teams may practice or scrimmage during the week at their own discretion.
5. Game Times 9:00am, 11:00am, 1:00pm, 3:00pm. **Unless otherwise posted**
6. All games will have **1 hour and 45-minute, finishing the batter time limit**.
7. Pitching Rules will vary within each division and will be described in Divisional Rules.
8. **No player will be allowed to play in 2 divisions. They can be registered only on 1 roster.**
9. **PITCHING RULE FOR ALL BASEBALL DIVISIONS:** If a pitcher pitches 20 or less pitches in the first game, they can pitch the remaining allowable pitches they have left in the second game.

Example: If a 10 yr. old pitches 19 pitches in game one, they will be allowed to pitch up to 56 pitches in the second game.

Rosters: A copy of your roster must be at the district office before you start play

Rosters will have no limit to number of players per team

Special Rules for each Baseball Division

"A" Division - (10 yr. old and under) This Division will play their games on Saturdays
This Division teams will play a one game schedule per Saturday

This division is designed for the younger, inexperienced players, which allows us to use greater latitude within the age range of the players.

Game Structure: This division will feature 1 game, being no more than 1 hour and 45 minutes. You may finish the batter only at this point.

Pitching: Pitch Count will be in effect for this Division.

- 7/8 yr. old - 50 Pitches
- 9 yr. old - 50 Pitches
- 10 yr. old - 75 Pitches

General Rules: For the first two weeks

1. Stealing will be allowed from first to third.
2. Bunting **will not be** allowed.
3. The Infield Fly Rule **will not be used** in this division.
4. The half inning will end with 3 outs or 5 runs, whichever occurs first.
5. The regular season 15/10 Run Rule is in effect in this division.
6. NO DROPPED THIRD STRIKE

General Rules: For the last three weeks

1. Stealing will be allowed from first to home.
2. Bunting will be allowed.
3. The Infield Fly Rule **will be used** in this division.
4. The half inning will end with 3 outs or 5 runs, whichever occurs first.
5. The regular season 15/10 Run Rule is in effect in this division.
6. NO DROPPED THIRD STRIKE

"B" Division - (12 yr. old and under) This Division will play their games on Sundays

This division is still for learning but has been designed to begin to allow players to further understand the game, as well as increase their skills.

Game Structure: This division will feature 2 games, back-to-back, with each game being no longer than 1 hour and 45 minutes. You may finish the batter only at this point.

Pitching: Pitch Count will be in effect for this division.

8 yr. old - 50 Pitches
9 yr. old - 75 Pitches
10 yr. old - 75 Pitches
11/12 yr. old - 85 Pitches

General Rules:

1. Stealing will be allowed.
2. Bunting will be allowed.
3. The Infield Fly Rule **will be used** in this division.
4. The regular season 15/10 Run Rule is in effect in this division
5. Dropped third strike will be used.

"C" - "D" Divisions - (12 - 14 yr. and 12- 16-year-old)

"C"- Division normally known as the **Junior Division** will play their games on Saturdays
Saturday games due to Field and Umpire availability

"D"- Division normally known as the **Senior Division** will play their games on Sundays

The players in these divisions are now ready to move to the 90' diamond, and for most of them it will be a learning experience. The age level is for 16 yr. old and under, however, there may be some allowable exceptions, which must be approved by District 8 first.

Game Structure:

At this level, the Little League Rule Book is in force, with the following exception. The game will be a 1- **9 inning game, as you will have a 2:45 hour time limit**. You may finish the batter only at this point. Mercy rule 10 runs after 7 innings

Pitching:

Baseball Pitch Count (per day) will be in effect for these divisions.

30 pitches or less you can finish your pitch count in a second game

12 - 16 yr. old - 95 Pitches

Umpire Fees

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Umpire fees will be paid to the umpires **prior** to the start of the game. Each Team is responsible to pay 1 umpire or split the fee in cases where there is only 1 umpire.

Baseball and Softball Game Breakdown:

"A and B" Division Games:

- 1 Blue Shirt or 1 Red Shirt - \$70.00 per game
- 2 Blue Shirts or 2 Red Shirts or combination of both - \$40.00 per umpire
- 1 Blue or Red Shirt with 1 Black Shirt:
 - Blue or Red Shirt - \$ 50.00
 - Black Shirt - \$ 30.00
- 1 Black Shirt - \$ 40.00 per game
- 2 Black Shirts - \$ 30.00 per umpire

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"C"/" D" Division Games:

- 1 Umpire - \$ 90.00 per game
- 2 Umpires - \$ 70.00 per umpire
