# What Is All Stars?

After the end of our regular Little League baseball season, we will put together All Star teams to participate in Little League Tournaments.

The Little League International Tournament is the most widely known youth sports tournament in the world. There are six levels of tournament play in Little League Baseball® and five within Little League Softball®, with opportunities for players ages 8 to 16. The tournaments start at the District level; teams must win their way to advance through the International Tournament. The 8- to 10-Year-Old and 9- to 11-Year-Old Tournaments culminate at the State Level, while the Little League, Little League Intermediate (50/70) Baseball, Junior League, and Senior League divisions all conclude at a World Series Tournament. Leagues pay a one-time fee to enter each team into the Little League International Tournament, with 100% of that fee returning to local Little League teams that advance through the International Tournament to help offset costs.

At the District 9 Tournament, we play against neighboring leagues such as Sammamish, Redmond North, and Issaquah. In 2021, our Majors All Star team won D9, then moved on to the Washington State tournament. They won Washington State, then went to San Bernardino, where they won the Northwest Regional Championship and advanced to the Little League World Series, representing Eastlake Little League before the world. Eastlake has had two teams go to the Little League World Series.



# How Many Teams?

Teams are based on age/levels.

- **8/9/10 (10U):** All players on this team will have participated at the Coast level during the 2026 season. 8, 9, and 10 year olds are eligible.
- **9/10/11 (11U):** Most, if not all, players on this team will have participated at the Majors level during the 2026 season. There are times when Coast-level players are selected for the 11U team. 9, 10, and 11-year-olds are eligible.
- **10/11/12 – MAJORS:** All players on this team played at the Majors level during the 2026 season.
- **Intermediate:** All players who played Intermediate.
- **Juniors:** All players who played Juniors.
- **Seniors:** All players who played Seniors.

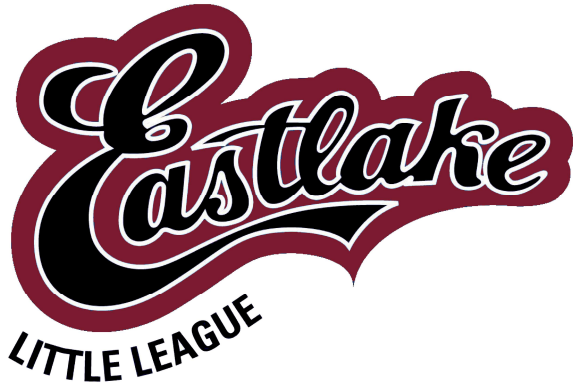


# Who Can Participate?

Anyone ages 8-16 who currently plays in levels Coast or above with Eastlake Little League and has played in at least 8 games during the regular season. (No minimum game requirement for Seniors.)

To be eligible, everyone who wants to play All Stars must provide proof of age and residence. All documents are sent to Little League International for verification.





# Commitment

The All Stars commitment is big! Everyone who registers for All Stars must sign a commitment letter at the time of registration. Why? Because if you are not able to make practices or games, you are taking a roster spot away from someone who wants to play and can make that commitment.

You can expect to practice 5 days per week before the tournament and to play weekend “pre-tournaments” leading up to the District 9 Tournament. The number of games won after that will depend on how many games are played.

Parents should know that participating in Tournament Play is a choice, and that while it is a privilege to play, it also entails additional practices and games. If you realize that your son or daughter has several conflicts, it may be wise to pass on a tournament selection and allow another Little Leaguer to share in the experience.

We ask that you postpone any summer vacations until after your All Star tournaments are completed.



# Rules



Most of the rules mirror what you have been seeing this season. However, there are some differences. Most notable are the minimum play requirements. All Tournament Teams must adopt a policy of a continuous batting order that includes all players on the team affidavit who are present at the start of the game. Each player is required to bat in his/her respective spot in the batting order. A player may be entered and/or re-entered defensively in the game at any time.\*

\*There are no minimum play requirements at the Seniors level



## Cost

**There is a \$150 fee** for each selected All-Star participant. A payment link will be sent once the team has been selected. **Players will not be allowed to play if payment is not received by Friday, June 12, 2026.** Big Diamond participants are not subject to the registration fee.

This fee will cover uniforms (All Star jersey, hat, and sweatshirt), equipment, field rentals, and other necessary expenses.

What it does not cover:

- Pre-Tournaments. Pre-tournaments are not Little League-sanctioned tournaments, and Little League funds cannot be used to pay for them. You can expect to pay roughly \$30-\$40 per tournament.
- Travel expenses. For any in-state travel, the families will cover lodging. Players' and coaches' airfare, lodging, and some food are covered for Regional and World Series Travel.
- Additional fees may be incurred at the coach's discretion for team-bonding activities (such as an Escape Room, Top Golf, etc.) and/or additional team-specific All Star swag



# All Star Voting and Team Selection



Eastlake Little League appoints a Tournament Team Committee in charge of the All Star voting and selection process. The Player Agent heads the TTC and consists of other board members. All voting and counting are conducted in secret, and results are not shared with anyone. Each ballot is counted by at least 3 members of the TTC and verified with the list of players and coaches who voted. For the full rules on our selection process, see page 45 of our local rules document on our website.

Every eligible Player and Manager who registers for All Stars will be put on a ballot. Every player at the Coast and Majors level will vote (if they choose) for up to 12 eligible players from the ballot and one Manager.

Each team at each level will have two coaches (Manager and Coach of Record) who vote. The team manager will select the Coach of Record for the team. Each Manager and Coach of Record will vote for 12 players on the ballot.

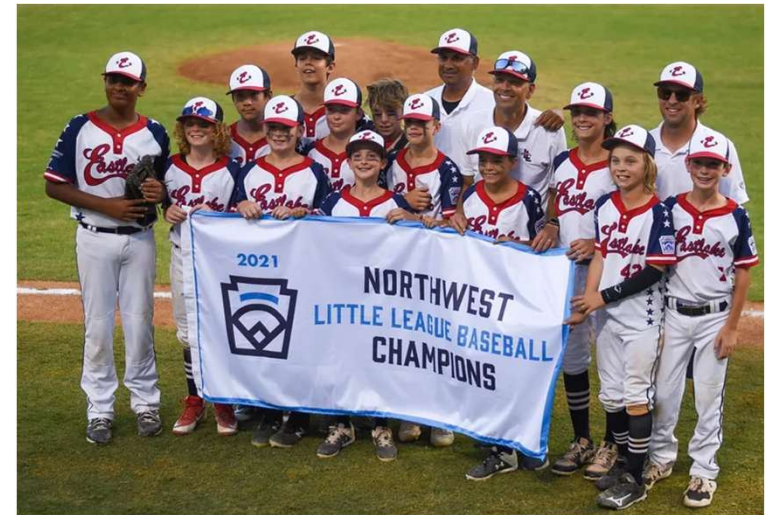
Players, Managers, and Coaches of Record at the Majors level will vote for the Majors and 9/10/11 teams. Players, Managers, and Coaches of Record at the Coast level will vote for the 8/9/10 team.

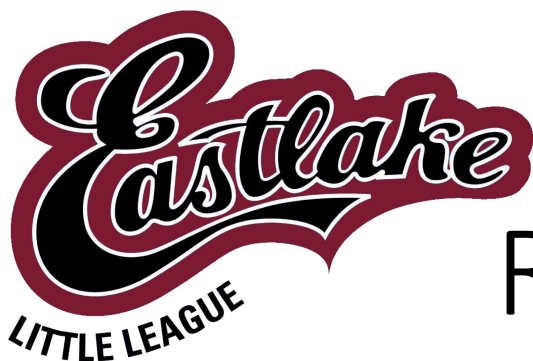


# All Star Voting and Team Selection cont.

The TTC compiles a list of the top 11 vote getters at each level by the Players' ballots and the top 11 vote getters by the Managers/Coaches' ballots.

All players on both Top 11 lists are automatically selected for the All Star team. The TTC provides the Manager with a list of players who were automatically selected for the All-Star team and a list of the remaining eligible players, and the Manager selects the remaining players for the roster. The minimum number of players on the Little League International Tournament roster is 12, and the maximum is 14 (Junior League Division and below; 16 maximum for Senior Division)





# Registration Forms

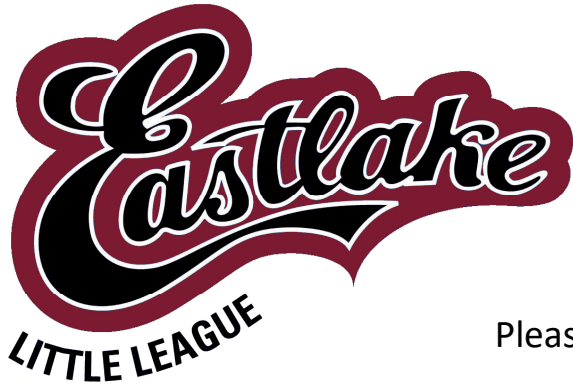
You will need to complete the 3 forms that are available under the Registration tab on our website, as well as provide an **Original Birth Certificate** once teams are announced.

1. **Tournament Player Verification**
2. **Medical Form**
3. **Proof of Residency: 2 Options** (You only need 1 of these Options)
  - A. **School Enrollment form** (signed by your School Administrator) if you attend: **Blackwell, Mead, Carson, Smith, McAuliffe, Renaissance, Inglewood, or Eastside Catholic.**
  - B. If you do not attend a school within Eastlake Little League boundaries, you will need to provide **Proof of Residency.**
