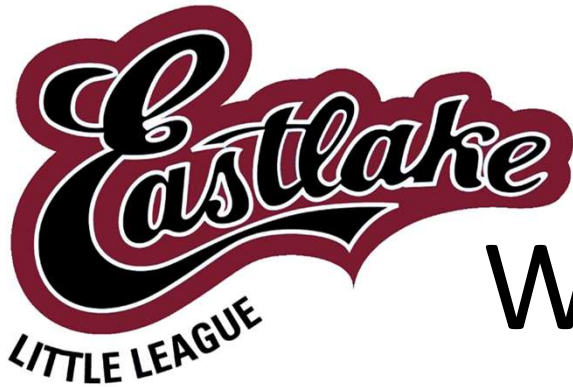




All Stars Information





What Are All Stars?

After the end of our Little League Regular Season, we will put together All Star teams to participate in Little League Tournaments.

The Little League International Tournament is the most widely known youth sports tournament in the world. There are six levels of tournament play in Little League Baseball® and five within Little League Softball®, with opportunities for players ages 8 to 16. The tournaments start at the District level, and teams must win their way to advance through the International Tournament. The 8- to 10-Year-Old and 9- to 11-Year-Old Tournaments culminate at the State Level, while the Little League and Junior League divisions conclude at a World Series Tournament. Leagues pay a one-time fee to enter each team into the Little League International Tournament, with 100 percent of that fee returning to local Little League teams that advance through the International Tournament to help offset costs.

At the District 9 tournament we play against neighboring leagues, like Sammamish, Redmond North, Issaquah, etc. In 2019, the Juniors All Star team won the D9 tournament and went on to win the Washington State and Regional tournaments, going all the way to the Little League World Series where they represented Eastlake Little League in front of the world. Pretty cool! Eastlake Little League Softball has had two teams reach the Little League World Series in the last 10 years.

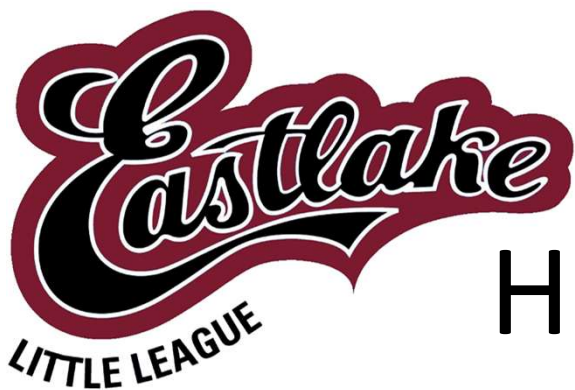


Who Can Participate?

Anyone ages 8-14 who play in levels AAA or above with Eastlake Little League and have played in at least 8 games during the regular season.

Everyone who wants to play All Stars will be required to provide proof of age and residence to be eligible. All documents are sent into Little League International for verification.

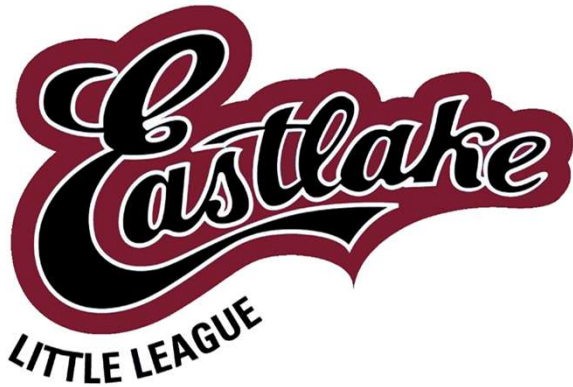




How Many Teams?

Teams are Based on Age/Levels.

- **8/9/10 (10U):** All players on this team will have participated on a Competitive level team – 8, 9, and 10 year olds are eligible.
- **9/10/11 (11U):** All players on this team will have participated on a Competitive level team – 9, 10, and 11 year olds are eligible.
- **Little League (MAJORS/12U):** All players on this team will have participated on a Competitive level team – 10, 11, and 12 year olds are eligible.
- **Juniors:** All players ages 12-14 who played on our Junior/Senior team (or potentially Majors team)



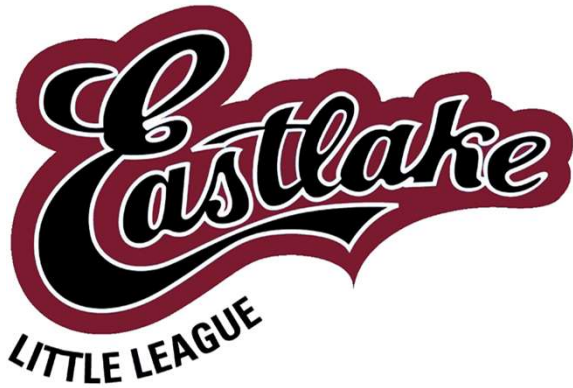
Commitment

The commitment for All Stars is big. Everyone who registers for All Stars must sign a commitment letter at registration. Why? Because if you are not able to make practices or games, you are taking a roster spot away from someone who wants to play and can make that commitment.

You can expect to practice 5 days per week prior to the tournament and play in weekend “pre-tournaments” leading up to the District 9 Tournament. After that, it will depend on the number of games that are won. See below for Dates and more Tournament details.

It’s important for parents to be reminded that participating in Tournament Play is a choice, and that while it is a privilege to play, it also entails additional practices and games. If you realize that your son or daughter has several conflicts, please discuss this with your Coach and/or Player Agent.

We ask that you postpone any Summer vacations until after your All Star tournaments are scheduled to be completed.



Rules



Most of the rules mirror what you have been seeing so far this season; there are some differences. Most notable are the minimum play requirements. All Tournament Teams must adopt a policy of a continuous batting order that will include all players on the team affidavit present at the start of the game, to appear in the batting order. Each player is required to bat in his/her respective spot in the batting order. A player may be entered and/or re-entered defensively in the game at any time. There are no minimum defensive playing time requirements.



Cost

There is a \$150 fee for each selected All-Star participant. A payment link will be sent once the team has been selected.

This fee will cover uniforms, including pants, an All Star shirt, and other swag, equipment, field rentals, and other necessary expenses.

What it does not cover:

- Pre-Tournaments. Pre-tournaments are not Little League-sanctioned tournaments, and Little League funds cannot be used to pay for them. You can expect to pay roughly \$30-\$40 per tournament.
- Travel expenses. Any in-state travel and lodging will be covered by the families. Players' and coaches' airfare, lodging, and some food are covered for Regional and World Series Travel.
- Additional fees may be incurred at the coach's discretion for team-bonding activities (such as an Escape Room, Top Golf, etc.) and/or additional team-specific All Star swag



All Star Team Selection

Eastlake Little League appoints a Tournament Team Committee (TTC) that is in charge of the All-Star selection process. The TTC is headed by the Player Agent and consists of other Softball Board members.

The first goal is to get enough players registered to make a team at all four levels. Teams can range from 10 to 14 players (12 is typical). If we do not have enough players for a specific team, TTC will try to combine with other leagues within District 9 to form a combined All-Star Team (e.g., in 2023, the 9/10/11 Beastlake team combined with Bellevue). Of course, the preference is to have all Eastlake-only teams – Go Eastlake!

TTC will select Managers for each team from competitive-level team coaches. Managers will determine how many players they want to carry on their teams.

TTC will work to get teams set and announced by no later than May 31st and practices start on June 2nd.



Tournament Dates and Locations

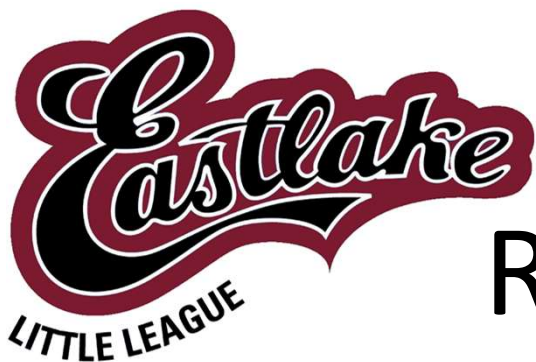

Registration Forms

You will need three forms that will be available under the registration tab on our website as well as your **Original Birth Certificate** once teams are announced.

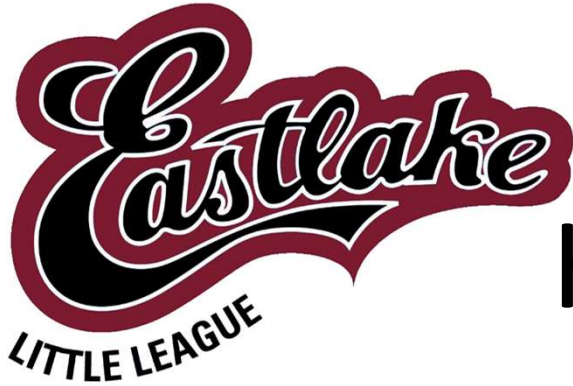
1. **Tournament Player Verification**
2. **Medical Form**
3. **Proof of Residency: 2 Options** (You only need 1 of these Options)
 - A. **School enrollment form** (signed by your School Administrator) if you attend: **Blackwell, Mead, Carson, Smith, McAuliffe, Renaissance, Inglewood, Eastlake, or Eastside Catholic.**
 - B. If you do not attend a school within Eastlake Little League boundaries, you will need to fill out **Proof of Residency.**

All forms will need to be emailed to softballallstars@eastlakell.org
