- Baseball

 - We have poles for baseball batting cage, will set it up in April.
 - Plan 2023 indoor training session closer to the season start date
- Softball-

- Soccer
 - Need 2023 Soccer Commissioner
 - Katie Bennette volunteered at the meeting to be next year's commissioner
 - End of season Celebration was a Plzza Party instead of BBQ
 - Cost: ~\$500 for 40 pizzas,

- Had 8 pizzas left over, maybe need 30 pizzas for next year.
- Cost of U10 tournament was not available as Brian May and Lisa Clark were not at the meeting, put on agenda for next meeting
- Talk to League about sharing ref costs between the towns next year
- We returned the U10 nets to Epsom (that we borrowed for tournament)
- School teams couldn't use Carpenter Park for game because nets were not the right size
 - Chris Weir organized a second set of middle school nets for Carpenter Park, will be on wheels so we can move when not in use

Snack Shack:

- U10 Tournament
 - Sold 781 units at tournament
 - Net Profit ~\$986
 - Sold 150 units at Trunk or Treat
- Chris Weir's suggestions
 - Opportunity to make more money (\$20-\$30K/year)
 - Use kids to help (Players from team and students for community service)
 - Create Snack Shack schedule before season starts to coaches can get volunteer (Players)
 - Chris offered to do the cooking
 - Get Wifi for Snack Shack
 - Parks and Rec has agreement with Comcast to get free internet in all town buildings
- Winter Preparation of Snack Shack
 - o Turn Water off, leave drain open during winter
 - Unplug fridge and freezer
 - Remove AEDs for winter (Store at someone's house)
 - When turning water back on in Spring, be sure to close valve before turning water back on (to avoid flooding of field)

Equipment Manager:

- Still need to decide how to use \$150 Dick's Gift card (expires at the end of December).
- Need 2023 Equipment Manager
 - Mallory Drew volunteered to be next year's Equipment Manager

Fundraising:
