- Baseball

 - We will not have an opening day celebration, we will have an end of season celebration instead

Snack Shack:

- We purchased Open Feather Flag \$39.99

 - We may need a volunteer for Monte Carlo hole because Terri hasn't heard back from our former volunteer
 - Need to have Shirt Masters order for shirts by September 4th or 5th to have shirts by Tournament
 - We will print Programs so people have access to the rules
 - \$300 deposit needed for LCC
 - Terri will meet with LCC next Thursday to discuss Tournament
 - o Post on Facebook requesting volunteers for Tournament, Raffle Prizes and Sponsors.

Other Business:

- Chelsea called Merrill Constructruction to discuss field maintenance but she hasn't heard anything back yet
- Parks and Rec Department will be submitting a plan for Carpenter Park Field Maintenance
 - Will get estimates about baseball fields updated
