Approval Of The Minutes: On a motion made by DeAnn Berthiaume seconded by Terri Lane the minutes from the June 20, 2025 meeting were approved with all members in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Chelsea shared the Treasurer's Report. She will work on getting accounts open at TD Bank and start slowly transitioning everything over. TD offers a Money Market account with 3.25% interest rate (would be about \$80/month). Chelsea will find out more about the account (minimum balance required, etc) and she will also find out more about the credit card with 2.75% rewards. Commissioners' Report:

- Baseball
 - Most baseball equipment has been turned in, still waiting on 3 teams
 - All stars went well, Placed 4 out of 5 teams.
 - Still have 1 more tourney
 - Need to reimburse coaches for \$50 coach certificate and background check.
 - Sarah will follow up with parents about Fall Ball
 - Pittsfield still owes \$150 for players
- Softball
 - Epsom Summer Clinic is going well.
- Soccer
 - 58 registrants so far vs 107 last year
 - 2 volunteers for coaching at each level (except 1 for U12)
 - Waiting to hear from Tony Cipriano about Middle school soccer schedule

- Need to schedule better so it doesn't interrupt CYA schedule
- League Mtg July 20th
- Commission Team will meet Mon 7/21 to discuss registrations/team rosters
- Meeting Thursday and Friday to line fields for Caramba
 - Will reach out to field maintenance volunteers about helping

Snack Shack: Coordinator absent, nothing to report as snack shack has been closed.

Equipment Manager:

- July 31st deadline for Soccer Uniforms
- Found 2 more corner flag poles, ordered 10 new flags
- Took Tees apart for storage.
- Line Paint is in the snack shack and paint markers are in the garage (last year bought 200 paint cans and used 90)

 - Shirts

 - Taylor Rental will be sponsoring a hole-in-one contest
 - Prize: Lawn mower (wants to park two mowers at the hole)
 - They will pay for the insurance policy
 - Allison MacIntosh would sit at hole (they have done other tournaments for other organizations)
 - We would need to take hole 13 off our policy to give to them

Other Business:

- Will need to make plan for watering fields after Merrill field work is complete on lower field
 - Chelsea will reach out about field work timeline and explore Hydroseeding options
 - Joe will explore options for watering
