Title: Uniform Policy

Purpose

Rebels Soccer Club strives to project a professional image at all times, of which the club uniform plays an integral part. The club uniform helps forge club identity and fosters pride in the organization. This is accomplished only if all Rebel Soccer Club (RSC) travel teams wear the club uniform. Therefore, all players and coaches will be asked to adhere to this uniform policy, effective with the Spring/Summer 2015 season.

Policies

The following outlines the RSC travel team uniform policies, effective with the Spring/Summer 2015 season.

1. All travel teams and coaches must adhere to this program.
2. All travel teams are required to purchase a new uniform kit every two years or as dictated by the Board. Uniforms shall be purchased and used in all league and tournament games immediately upon availability. Contact the RSC Director of Operations at operations@rebelsoccer.net for information on ordering uniforms.
 - a. Exceptions: For teams that are in their final year in the club's travel program, if that year coincides with the launch of a new uniform kit, that team will not be required to purchase the new kit, and will be permitted to finish their tenure with their current kit.
3. All RSC coaching staff and players must wear uniforms and RSC shirts on game day.
4. The official RSC travel uniform consists of the following items. This uniform must be worn at all times (league matches, tournament matches, etc. - - anytime the team is playing under the club affiliation):
 - a. Home uniform: Navy jersey and navy shorts
 - b. Away uniform: White jersey and navy shorts
 - c. Socks: Navy socks

5. Optional club and player equipment will be available through our uniform distributor. Contact the RSC Director of Operations at operations@rebelsoccer.net for information on the uniform distributor.
 - a. Warm-up jacket
 - b. Warm-up pants
 - c. Backpack
6. Uniform numbers: For coordinating uniform numbers, contact the RSC Director of Operations at operations@rebelsoccer.net.
 - a. Only single or double digit numbers are allowed.
 - b. Jersey numbers within an age group (boys or girls) should not be duplicated. Each player in an age group will have their own unique number. Non-conflicting jersey numbers allow for players to play with other teams in the age group, as league and tournament rules allow.
 - c. Only the 'blood jersey' for each team can use the number 99.
7. Uniform Kit Modifications: Modifications to the RSC travel uniforms are not permitted.
8. Sponsorship logos may not be placed on the travel soccer uniform kit (jersey, shorts, or socks) without approval of the RSC Soccer Board. Sponsorship logos must be first approved by the RSC Soccer Board before being placed on any uniform item Contact the RSC President at president@rebelsoccer.net for Board meeting dates/times.
9. Players' names are not permitted on uniforms (i.e. on the back of jerseys).
10. Teams may use the RSC travel uniform for indoor league play and other approved tournaments, as long as the team is registered as a RSC team. A RSC travel team playing in an event where they are not registered as a RSC team may not wear the RSC travel uniform.
11. RSC reserves the right to impose fines to teams that do not get prior approval before deviating from these policies.
