

Parsells Field Daily Maintenance

- ⊘ **DO NOT WALK ON TARPS!**
- ⊘ **NO METAL CLEATS ON MOUND!**

Turf shoes or molded cleats only.

Violators risk fine and/or loss of facility use privileges.

◆ Before Practice/Game

- Bring the **cart for tarp weights** out from the shed.
 - Remove weights from the **home plate** and **mound tarps**; place weights on the cart.
 - **Fold and store** tarps neatly on the cart, **out of play**.

◆ After Practice/Game

- **Rake dirt back** into batter's boxes and catcher's area.
 - ⚠ Do **NOT** rake dirt from the **infield** toward home plate creating a low spot in front of home plate.
 - ✓ **Rake** from the **sides or behind** the plate.
 - ● Ensure this area **slopes toward the backstop** for proper drainage.
 - **Tamp down** the batter's box and catcher's area.
 - Replace both **home plate & mound tarps** with weights and return the cart to the shed.
 - ✓ **Rake** infield dirt from **high to low areas** (especially around bases)
 - **Store** bases, rakes, screens, liners, etc in the shed in an organized manner.

◆ General Guidelines

- ✗ **DO NOT push, drag, or rake dirt into the grass**; this creates a lip at the grass cut.
 - ✓ **Replace** all 6 base plugs in base anchors.
 - The field is tractor-dragged on weekdays (weather permitting).
 - On **Fridays & Saturdays**, teams must **hand-drag** the field after their events.
 - ✗ **DO NOT drag the screen onto or through the grass.**

◆ Field & Dugout Etiquette

- ✓ Leave the field, dugouts and shed **cleaner than you found them**.
