Steps for Announcing All-Star Games

Preparation:

1. Get lineups from managers with first and last names of the starters and non-starters, shirt and position numbers and names of managers and coaches. Go over name pronunciation with the manager.

If also keeping score:

1. Get affidavits from the managers to list all pitchers used. Sign and return to the managers after the game.

Announcing:

1. "Welcome to _____ home of _____ Little League, for game number _____ of the _____ game between _____ and _____."
2. "In All-Star play, all fields are considered neutral and _____
The home team has been determined by a coin toss and occupies the third base dugout."
3. Announce both teams starting with the visitors-, then managers and coaches. Then Home team, Use Full Names, numbers and positions. They will line up on respective baselines.
4. Announce umpires and positions they will umpire.
5. Play National Anthem and LL pledge.
6. Announce each batter's full name and position
7. Announce any changes in the lineup or fielding position changes and or pitch count.
8. Announce each ½-inning results- runs, hits, errors and runners left on base and pitch count.
9. SUGGESTION - At the end of the 3rd inning, announce that a collection is being taken to help defray the tournament costs (Travel, administration, etc.) After the collection is taken, announce the amount that is collected and thank everyone for donating.
10. Announce to have all foul balls returned to the scorer's table
11. After the game, announce the line score and where the winners and loser, unless eliminated will play next.
