

Registering Teams to Northwest District

In this documentation you will find instructions on how to register for the League as an Integrated Sports Connect Club user, as a non Sports Connect Club user, and how to view registered teams.

There are three situations in which you may fall under:

- 1. You have an <u>Integrated Sports Connect Club portal</u> and you **have** Affiliated to the Northwest district in your Registration.
- 2. You have an <u>Integrated Sports Connect Club portal</u> and you **have not** Affiliated to the Northwest district in your Registration but to Connecticut Junior Soccer Association.
- 3. You **do not** have an Integrated Sports Connect Club portal and will need to create your teams in Connecticut Junior Soccer Association and then later Upload your Player Data.

Which situation is my club in?

If your club does not use SportsConnect (AKA BlueSombrero) for club registrations, then you will want to follow the steps for "Non-Sports Connect Club Users".

If your club uses SportsConnect, then you will want to check how you set up your registration. Go to Registration → Registration Forms, and on the program for your current season travel teams, click the pencil icon, and select Program Settings. If your "Club" and "Program" are both the name of your organization, then you **are not** Affiliated. If the "Club" field shows a club within the Northwest district and the Program shows your club name, then you **are** Affiliated. Note that almost all of the steps are the same whether you are affiliated or not.



Integrated Sports Connect Club Users

Submitting Teams from the Club to the State

- 1. Create your Teams in Sports Connect Club.
- 2. Add at least 1 person (either Player or Admin) to each team, and submit teams to the state using the "Submit Teams to CJSA" button shown below.


Note: This doesn't always submit all teams so you may need to iterate on this process until the teams are all submitted (switch to another Division and back again to check on the status for each Division). You're done when all the team buttons say "Team Status".



3. Login to Association Connect via Single Sign On - use the silhouette icon on the upper right and select "Go to Connecticut Junior Soccer Association".



4. Once in the dashboard view, scroll down to the Team Counts widget. Click on the Total Number of Teams to view all of your teams.



5. In Team Lookup, you will see a list of all teams submitted from your Sports Connect Club portal. Make sure all the teams you submitted are listed here - if they are not you may need to go back to your Club login and re-submit the teams not listed. Note: **Be sure that the dropdown at the top shows the current season selected** (if not, switch the dropdown and then click the Search button).


Applying/Registering Teams to the League

Once your teams are in the State Association product (see above), they may be registered to the league (CJSA) for the desired season.


You may register teams to the league individually or as a batch. Note that there is a \$5 surcharge (on top of team fees) for each application. Registering all teams in one batch is highly recommended since each batch is only one application so you will only be charged one \$5 surcharge for all teams.

Registering Multiple Teams to the League

1. To submit multiple teams to the league, choose Teams -> Declare Multi Teams




2. Choose the desired season for "Tournament and League". For "Registration League", if your travel program <u>is affiliated</u> to CJSA, then choose the NWD. If it is <u>not affiliated</u> then choose the name of your club. Then click Start Application.



- 3. Select your Club name in the dropdown box then click Search. Only teams that meet the qualifications to play in the respective tournament/ league will appear in the search results.
- 4. Check the boxes for each team you wish to apply. You can select all teams by clicking the checkbox in the red header row. Once selections have been made, click Apply Teams.
- 5. The Verify and Submit screen will display all the teams you have selected on the previous page. If a team was selected in error, click the Remove link across from the team name to eliminate them

from this list. Once the list of teams has been verified, click Submit Applications.



6. The team status will now show as "In Progress". To complete the registration you will need to submit payment information by clicking the "Go" link in the Payment column.


NOTE: If you leave this screen and need to access the payment screen later, do the following: Under Teams -> Team Lookup choose any of the teams you have submitted but have not completed the payment process for. Then click the Tournament tab and click the "payment" link at the bottom right next to the registration - see below.

7. On the payment screen you have a few options for paying. If you have ACH debit set up with Stack Sports, choose the "ECheck" option. If you **do not** have ACH debit set up, choose the "Check" option and enter the check # (if known) - this indicates that you will be sending in the payment at a later time. Note: If you choose a credit card, there will be a % surcharge added to your amount due!




Note: After you submit your payment, you may see one or two screens that have an **incorrect amount due or amount paid**. This is a known issue that Stack is aware of. For now, you can ignore the incorrect amounts and continue on.

8. For each team submitted, now go and select the division you are requesting for that team. To do this, go to Teams -> Team Lookup. Select each team in turn, then go to the Tournament tab and click the "edit" link next to the season you just registered for.




9. Choose the desired division from the "Preferred Flight" dropdown and click the Save button.




Registering Single Teams to the League

Follow the above process if you have multiple teams to register. If you just need to register a single team, you can follow this somewhat simpler process.

In Team Lookup, you will see a list of all teams submitted from your Sports Connect Club portal.
Be sure that the dropdown at the top shows the current season selected (if not, switch the dropdown and then click the Search button). Click on the Team Name you want to register.




2. Once the team pulls up, click on the Tournament tab and select the league and season name from the drop-down menu. Click Register.




- 3. Choose the desired division from the "Preferred Flight" dropdown and click Save (see above).
- 4. Once on the Review tab click Submit Application.
- 5. Note that you must complete payment before the team is actually registered to the league! See above section for how to do that.

Non-Sports Connect Club Users

- 1. Create teams in Association https://cisa.sportsaffinity.com/
- 2. This can be accomplished by logging into your Sports Connect Association account that's used to submit player and adult registrations to the state. If you don't have your username and password please either contact support **800-808-7195** or the State Office.
- 3. Click on Teams in the Navigation.
 - i. Click Create to create one team at a time
 - ii. Click Team Creation Matrix to create multiple teams at once






4. Once all teams have been created, follow the Registering Multiple Teams to the League section above.


View Teams that are Registered

Team Lookup

1. Click on Teams in the navigation bar, select Team Lookup.




- 2. Search for your teams.
- 3. Once teams have been submitted to the League you will see a green D with a circle for team Declared into a League, as shown below.




Tournament Team Report

You can run a report to make sure all teams have been registered.

1. Click on Team Reports



2. Select Report Type: Tournament Team Application



- 3. Click Generate Report
- 4. You can export the report and sort as needed
