Bracket Explanation for the PYSA Fall Cup

Consolation games can end in a tie. No shootout in Consolation games.

Games that are semifinals are 1st Bracket A vs. 1st Bracket C and 1st Bracket B vs. 1st Bracket D

Groups of 3 teams- 1 bracket of 3. Each team plays 2 games in their bracket, with the 2nd in points playing the 3rd in points in a semifinal and the winner of the semifinal will play the 1st in points in the final.

Groups of 4 teams – 1 bracket of 4. Each team plays 3 games in their bracket, with the 1st in points and the 2nd in points playing in the final.

Groups of 5 teams- 1 bracket of 5. Each team plays 2 games in their bracket. The 4th in points and the 5th in points play a play-in game with the winner playing the 1st in points in a semifinal. The 2nd in points and the 3rd in points will play in a semifinal. The winners of each semifinal will play in the final.

Groups of 6 teams - 2 brackets of 3. Each team plays 2 games in their bracket, with the 1st in points from each bracket playing in the Final. Crossover consolation games will be as follows: 2nd in bracket A vs. 2nd in bracket B and 3rd in bracket A vs. 3rd in bracket B.

Groups of 7 teams- 1 bracket of 4 and one bracket of 3. The bracket of 4 teams play 3 bracket games and the bracket of 3 play 2 bracket games, with the 1st in points from each bracket playing in the Final. Crossover consolation games will be as follows: 2nd in bracket A vs. 2nd in bracket B and 3rd in bracket A vs. 3rd in bracket B. The 4th in points in the 4 team bracket does not have a consolation game.

Groups of 8 teams – 2 brackets of 4. Each team plays 3 games in their bracket, with the 1st in points from each bracket playing in the Final.

Groups of 12 teams – 4 brackets of 3. Each team plays 2 games in their bracket, with the 1st in points from each bracket playing in the semifinals to see who will play in the Final.

Crossover consolation games will be as follows: 2nd in bracket A vs. 2nd in bracket B, 3rd in bracket A vs. 3rd in bracket B, 2nd in bracket C vs. 2nd in bracket D, and 3rd in bracket C vs. 3rd in bracket D.
