1) SKEDDA (Doug)

- Price went up considerably, not sure as to why but fee is roughly \$1,400 for the year. Brielle and Doug spoke and figured with how many are using it this year we will keep it for this year while we revisit options for the new year.
- Brielle and Kevin are talking about assigning practice times and locations to all teams to simplify the process.

2) Umpires (Mario)

- 25 have shown interest for the season, 3 adults only.
- Ian, Mario and Rick will jump in as needed.
- Per LL rules, we have to have adults ump the Major teams at the plate.
- Can always use more umpires
- 2 clinics are set to go; we agreed that the youth need to attend one to start the season. Adults only need to acknowledge Major team rules.
- Uniforms have been picked up, will connect with Brielle if more are needed.
- We need 4 sets of umpire equipment.

3) Field Set-up (Travis)

- Feb 11/12 – fences will go up by rental company.
- TBD if they can build the batting cages, but we will ask once the company is on-site.
- Feb 15 is full field setup; breakfast will be provided to those who volunteer.
- TSLL windscreens can all be hung this day as well.



4) Registration & Team Status (Kevin)

- 600 roughly registered with 35 on the waitlist. We are working hard to get as many of those assigned to teams as it allows.
- Most of our growth has come from the younger division that then bring their siblings.

5) Rules Committee Meeting Vote (Kevin)

- AAA extra innings will only have 4 batters not 8.
- Keeping 3rd dropped strike
- Majors 6 and 7 place will play for last place in the pool. Top 4 then play single elimination.
- Minors pool of 4, single elimination as well.
- AAA bottom 4 play out, top 8 then play.
- Jenn Coughlin will create an FAQ about the changes to the playoffs for this year to hand out to all managers so it is clear how it works.

6) Team Schedules (Kevin)

- Kevin has a rough draft of T-ball, AA and AAA practices to keep everyone even and prevent issues.
- This was the process from the fall and it worked well without complaints.

7) Fundraising Status (Robyn)

- 11 hats ordered to date only one to ship
- Baseballism started today (Travis/Jason will go to the store to manage the day of). Code is valid online or in-store.
- D-backs link has been sent as well as the flyer.
- Socks/Belts are also available with a fundraiser

8) Silent Auction, Banners, etc. (Robyn)

- We decided to not do a silent auction at Opening Day due to the complexity of the day. This is being moved to our Annual Picnic and will allow for more participation.
- Banners are at \$16,300 in revenue now. All have been emailed from last year. Some requested invoices as they have to pay via check.

9) Shirts for BOD

- It was agreed to provide one shirt per board member this year to wear at games.



10) Game Changer Training

- The league will send out the video that JP Coughlin created as our training this year.

11) Opening Day & Picture Day (Brielle & Jenn)

- Team photos will be 9-11:30am, older first with younger ones closer to 11:30am.
- One team photo will be done and it will be set on T-ball field.
- Teams can opt-out of the photo day.
- Jenn Coughlin will assign every team a spot and it will be emailed out to all.
- Marcus is hired again to do candid shots during Opening Day and one game per team throughout the season. He does not have a schedule to hand out, but Jenn will ask him if he can alert her when he is coming so coaches are aware of it.
- Brielle will send out a link to help with various tasks.
- Every T-ball team will play on Opening Day, 3 AA games play, 2 Minors, 1 Major, 1 AAA game.
- Every team will have a game the next week minus one Major team.

12) Treasurer Report (Ed)

13) Taxes (Ed)

- Brielle has reached out to the person in charge last year for access to the site and is waiting to hear back. We cannot file until that is handled.
