for the playoffs.

TWO SINGLE ELIMINATION BRACKETS

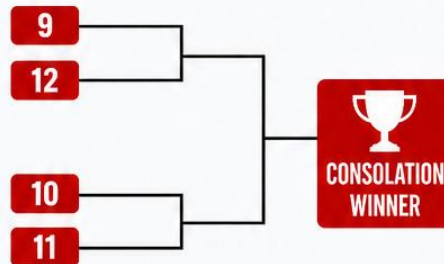
Seeds 1–8 in Championship Bracket
Seeds 9–12 in Consolation Bracket

CHAMPIONSHIP BRACKET (SEEDS 1–8)



CONSOLATION BRACKET (SEEDS 9–12)



★ ALL BRACKETS ARE SINGLE ELIMINATION – WIN OR GO HOME.

HOW ARE TEAMS SEEDED FOR BRACKET

- 1 Most Wins During the Season
- 2 Most Putouts During the Season in Total
- 3 Head to Head (If more than two teams, then go to a Blind Draw)
- 4 Coin Flip

MINORS DIVISION PLAYOFF FORMAT

8 TEAMS. 1 CHAMPION.
EVERY GAME MATTERS.

STEP 1: POOL PLAY (2 POOLS OF 4)



8 teams are split into two pools of four.

Each team plays the other three teams in their pool.

TOP 2 TEAMS FROM EACH POOL ADVANCE.

POOL A

Seeds 1, 4, 5, 8



Each team plays 3 games in pool play.

POOL B

Seeds 2, 3, 6, 7



Each team plays 3 games in pool play.

HOW ARE TEAMS SEEDED FOR POOL PLAY?

- 1 Most Wins (ties excluded)
- 2 Highest Winning Percentage (Tied are 0.5 win)
- 3 Lowest Runs Allowed
- 4 Highest Run Differential
- 5 Head to Head
- 6 Coin Flip

STEP 2: CHAMPIONSHIP BRACKET (SINGLE ELIMINATION)

Top 2 teams from each pool advance to a single elimination bracket.



HOW ARE TEAMS SEEDED FOR BRACKET?

- 1 Most Wins in Pool

MAJORS DIVISION PLAYOFF FORMAT

7 TEAMS. 1 CHAMPION.
EVERY GAME MATTERS.

STEP 1: PLAY-IN GAME (SINGLE ELIMINATION)

6-SEED VS 7-SEED
One game.
Winner advances to **pool play**.



SEEDING (7 TEAMS)

1 AUTO-BID 2 AUTO-BID 3 AUTO-BID 4 AUTO-BID 5 AUTO-BID 6 7

PLAY-IN GAME
6-SEED VS 7-SEED
WINNER ADVANCES TO **POOL PLAY**

HOW ARE TEAMS SEEDED?

- 1 Most wins against TSLL teams (Chandler and Guadalupe games excluded, ties excluded)
- 2 Highest winning percentage against TSLL teams (Chandler and Guadalupe games excluded, Ties are 0.5 win)
- 3 Lowest runs allowed
- 4 Highest run differential
- 5 Head to head
- 6 Coin flip

STEP 2: POOL PLAY (2 POOLS OF 3)

After the play-in game, teams are split into two pools of three.

TOP 2 TEAMS FROM EACH POOL ADVANCE.

POOL A

Each team plays the other two teams in their pool.

STEP 3: CHAMPIONSHIP BRACKET (SINGLE ELIMINATION)

Top 2 teams from each pool advance to a single elimination bracket.
