Boys Equipment 101



Gear Checklist:

Green may overlap with other sports, others are boys lacrosse specific. Shared specialized goalie gear is provided by the club as needed.

- **1)** Stick Most players use a midfield/attack stick (pictured) which are 40-42" long with plastic lacrosse head attached.
- **2)**Helmet with statement or seal (pictured) indicating it meets NOCSAE ND041 standards and SEI certification.
- 3) <u>Chest Protector</u> with statement or seal (pictured) indicating it meets NOCSAE ND200 standards and SEI certification.
- 4) Arm Pads
- 5) Gloves
- 6) Mouthguard
- 7) Athletic cleats or shoes personal preference (e.g. football / soccer). Metal spikes (e.g track) are illegal.
- 8) Protective Cup
- **Uniform** ordered via team store (link will be sent).

Sticks – can be customized for various positions and styles of play. The choices can be overwhelming, and many come with strings that have not yet been formed into a good "pocket". Coach Rob recommends StringKing which he uses himself at advanced levels but also works immediately "out of the box" for beginners. Length: Attack/Midfield for most. Defense/Goalie for players are certain to play that position. Jr okay for U8/10.

NOCSAE Standards / SEI Certification-
