

2026 FLYFCL Certification FAQ's

When is certification?

2026 Certification will be held the week of August 17th - 21st, times TBD

What does my club need to bring to certification?

All the required documentation for the board, coaches and players; refer to the Certification Cheat Sheet for more specifics.

What needs to be highlighted on each page?

The child's name, date of birth, age and grade should be highlighted

What if a family does not have the child's birth certificate?

Acceptable forms include but are not limited to adoption certificate, visa, passport, paternity acknowledgement and other documents as deemed appropriate by the FLYFCL Executive Board.

What size picture should we ask families for?

A wallet size works best

When does a physical need to be dated to be used for the 2026 season?

Physicals must be dated after 8/1/2025 to be used for the 2026 season. Physicals must be signed by a physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner with a statement that the youth is free from contagious disease and able to participate in sports/gym without restrictions. A visit summary is not an acceptable physical documentation as it is not signed.

Why do I have to provide grade verification as part of registration?

FLYFCL football and cheerleading squads are based upon grade, which makes it essential that we verify the grade of each participant.

What is acceptable for proof of grade?

Acceptable forms include but are not limited to report card, class placement announcement, grade placement letter on school letterhead, print out from the school districts electronic system that includes date and the assigned grade level and other documents as deemed appropriate by the FLYFCL Executive Board.

Can I use a physical as the proof of grade?

No

What about a child that is home-schooled or entering UPK/K?

Contact a member of the FLYFCL Executive Board to work through this situation.

What happens if a coach or player cannot be certified on the scheduled date?

They are immediately excluded from participating in all club activities until all documentation is received and certified by a member of the FLYFCL Executive Board.
