California District 37 has the pleasure this year to host the Section 4 Tournaments. Intermediate 50-70 Baseball, Major Baseball

PLEASE GIVE THIS INFORMATION TO YOUR LEAGUES

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All games will be played with Little League Approved Baseballs & Softballs.

All equipment and uniforms must conform to the Rule Book, including the appropriate Little League Patch on the left sleeve.

All helmets **MUST** have warning labels and safety approved.

All teams bring 2 (two) sets of catcher's equipment.

Teams at game site 1 (One) hour prior to game time.

Managers meet with the Tournament Director 45 minutes prior to game time for the flip of the coin to determine HOME and VISITOR designations and receive line-up cards. Home team will occupy the 3rd base dugout. Managers need California Concussion Awareness Verification.

Line -up cards (4 Copies) must be presented to the Tournament Director 45 minutes prior to game time. NO paper substitutes, e.g., scratch or note paper, etc. will be accepted. Full name of player will be on the line-up and all subs at the bottom of the line up not on the side. **ALL SUBSTITUTE PLAYERS MUST BE LISTED ON THE LINE-UP CARD WITH UNIFORM NUMBERS.**

Managers ONLY may discuss calls with the umpires.

Managers and Coaches or Players CANNOT leave the dugout for any reason without permission of the Umpire. No coaches or parents outside of the dugout may talk to the players or coaches in the dugout during the game.

Managers and /or Coaches that come on the field without permission from the Umpire may be ejected.

All players must be in uniform, uniform jerseys MUST be tucked into pants, and all hats and visors will be worn in the correct manner with the bill forward at all times.

All jewelry MUST be removed prior to the start of the game.

Dress Code for Managers and Coaches, male or female: Coaches shorts or long slacks, polo type shirts and neatly worn T-shirts, NO TANK TOPS, shoes and socks, NO SANDALS. Coaches as a base coach may not have cell phone or keys hanging from there pants.

League officials and representatives will be responsible for the conduct of their Leagues spectators and players, managers and coaches.

Ice chests coolers or picnic baskets will not be allowed: Snack Bar facilities will be available at the game site.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED in or around the field or park. OFFENDERS WILL BE REMOVED for the balance of the Tournament. NO COURTESY WARNING WILL BE GIVEN.

All the above rules are to ensure that the CHILDREN have a good experience competing in this Tournament, without outside distractions. The co-operation of everyone is needed.
