- **Call to Order:** President Tiffany called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.
- **Roll Call/Establish Quorum:** Secretary Kojzarek called the roll. 10 of 12 members were present, constituting a quorum of the Board. Members of the Board in attendance included:

- **Approval of the Agenda:** On a motion duly made and seconded, the Board approved the Agenda as presented.
- **Approval of Minutes:** The Board approved the Minutes of the January 2026 Meeting on a motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried.
- **Board Reports**
 - a. **VP of Football Operations:** In the absence of a VP of Football, President Tiffany reported on the following items:
 - Met with Coach Foster of HHS, and are excited to start working in collaboration with him. He appears to be the partner we have been looking for at the high school level.
 - b. **Directors of Cheer:** Director Moreno reported on the following items:
 - Uniforms and Poms have been ordered and will arrive well before the start of the season.
 - We conducted a survey of the parents from last season and received positive responses as well as some constructive feedback that we will work to implement in the coming season.
 - Registration is on pace with last season’s number.
 - c. **Dir. of Football Operations:** Director Zepeda reported on the following items:
 - As of this morning we have 63 coaching applications and over 100 returning players registered.
 - d. **Secretary:** Secretary Kojzarek addressed the following items:
 - All 3 of our municipalities have honored our academic scholars with a resolution at their Board Meetings. Chicagoland Pop Warner help their recognition reception as well which was very well attended.
 - e. **Treasurer:** Treasurer Garbrecht was not present due to a medical procedure.
 - f. **Dir. of Events & Fundraising:** Director Rodgers addressed the following items:
 - Met with roughly 80 businesses looking for sponsorships and community partners.
 - We have several Dine Outs that are being scheduled for Wendy’s, Panera, Double R Dogs, Harts Garage and Neon Cow. Dates and additional information will be posted on the website and advertised through social media.
 - g. **Dir. of Concessions:** Dir. May was not present due to a death in the family.
 - h. **Dir. of Spirit Wear:** Dir. Bentley reported on the following items:
 - The online spirit wear store is now live. We are using the same vendor as the high school, with 20% of all sales being donated to the organization. We have 2 additional local vendors slated to supply us items for sale at concessions.
 - i. **Dir. of Field Maintenance:** Dir. Moreno had no report.
 - j. **Dir. of Equipment:** Dir. Cline reported on the following items:





- All remaining equipment that was not sent out for recertification is being sent out for cleaning, repairs and sanitization on Saturday.
- k. **Dir. of Health & Safety:** Dir. Jarovsky had no report at this time.
- l. **Dir. of Certifications:** Dir. Dvorin reported on the following items:
 - We will be purchasing Adobe software to allow for parents to complete forms online. The \$15 cost is added in the budget.
- **President's Report:** President Tiffany discussed the following items:
 - Chicagoland Pop Warner is proposing a new tiered divisional system, that is now merit based. Each team's divisional position will be determined by a mathematical formula based on the prior season, thus eliminating unfair "sandbagging" where an all-star caliber team declares for a lower division to make an easy path to Nationals. Only the top 25% of teams would qualify for the "Red" division, and will be able to compete past State. The next 50% of the teams will be in the "White" division which will be able to compete for a State Championship. The remaining 25% will be in the "Blue" division and have a post-season bowl game against a team with a similar record.
 - Patches will only be required for Red division team, allowing us to pursue better uniform vendors.
 - The Jamboree will be scheduled for August 15th at Jacobs High School
- **Members to be Heard/Old Business:** President Tiffany opened the floor to visitors in attendance. Members of the audience were given the opportunity to voice their concerns and ask questions of the Board.
- **New Business**
 - a. On a motion made and seconded, the Board unanimously approved the 2026 Budget
- **Closed Session**
 - a. On a motion duly made seconded and unanimously carried, the Board adjourned to closed session at 8:26pm for the purposes of discussing hardship scholarships.

Adjournment: The Board adjourned the meeting at 8:45pm. The Board stands adjourned until the next meeting scheduled on March 16, 2026 at Resource Bank in Hampshire beginning at 7:30pm.
